ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

REGISTERED REPRESENTATIVE BARRED AND FINED \$100,000 IN CONNECTION WITH SALE OF DERIVATIVE SECURITIES

The Commission announced on June 11 the institution and settlement of an administrative proceeding against Gary S. Missner, a former registered representative of BT Securities Corporation. Without admitting or denying the findings, Missner consented to the entry of an order requiring him to permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violations or future violations of the antifraud and reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. The Order provides that Missner be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment company or investment advisor with a right to reapply for association to the appropriate self-regulatory organization after five years from the date of the Order. Missner simultaneously entered into a settlement with the Federal Reserve Board. In settlement of both proceedings, Missner agreed to pay a single civil penalty of \$100,000.

Missner's violations stem from his participation in the offer and sale of derivatives to Gibson Greetings, Inc. During the period from October 1992 to March 1994, Missner knowingly misled Gibson about the value of the company's derivatives positions by providing Gibson with values that significantly understated the magnitude of Gibson's losses. Specifically, on two occasions while preparing its financial statements, Gibson sought valuations of its derivatives. On those occasions, Missner participated in providing Gibson with valuations which understated Gibson's losses by more than 50%. Gibson used the valuations to prepare the financial statements As a result, Gibson's financial included in its Form 10-K. statements materially understated the company's losses related to derivatives. The Commission found that in providing the understated valuations, Missner caused Gibson to violate Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20 and 13a-1.

The Order also finds that certain of the derivatives that BT Securities sold to Gibson were securities within the meaning of the federal securities laws. According to the Order, Missner knowingly made material misstatements and omissions to Gibson in connection with these transactions. Accordingly, the Commission found that Missner committed violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. (Rel. SETTLEMENT REACHED WITH DOROTHY BRENNA

The Commission announced that on June 11 Dorothy J. Brenna submitted an Offer of Settlement, which the Commission has accepted, under which she is barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. The Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions alleges, in part, that Brenna has been permanently enjoined by judgment of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas, in an action styled SEC v. Strategic Management. Inc. et al, USDC, N.D./Tex. (Dallas Division), CA No. 3:91CV2489-R, from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws based upon findings of willful violations of the federal securities laws in connection with her participation in the distribution of a fraudulent proxy statement on behalf of four registered investment companies. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST HENRY BECKER

The Commission announced that on June 11 it simultaneously instituted and settled public proceedings against Henry P. Becker. Becker consented to the issuance of an Order Instituting Public Proceedings Pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Making Findings, and Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist (Order), without admitting or denying the Commission's findings.

On the basis of the Order-and Becker's Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that, from approximately August 1993 through approximately February 1994, Becker made material misrepresentations and failed to disclose material information to prospective investors concerning their purchase of securities issued by T.B.F.G. International, Ltd. (TBFG). TBFG, which is now defunct, purportedly engaged in trade with, financing for, and consulting to, developing businesses in Russia and other states of the former Soviet Union.

The Commission's Order directs Becker to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation and any future violation of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and Section 17(a) of the Securities Act. (Rel. 33-7303; 34-37299)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS ORDERED AGAINST FU-SUNG PETER WU

The Commission announced that on June 11 public administrative proceedings were instituted against Fu-sung Peter Wu. The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges, in part, that from approximately June 1995 through August 1995, Wu violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws by making material misrepresentations and omissions and unsuitable recommendations to investors in connection with the solicitation of orders for Communications Corp. stock. The Order further alleges that Wu made unauthorized transactions in customer accounts and altered customer account documents in connection with executing transactions in customer accounts. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE CHASE MANHATTAN BANK, N.A. AND CHEMICAL BANK

An order has been issued on an application filed by The Chase Manhattan Bank, N.A. (Chase) and Chemical Bank (Chemical) under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(f) of the Act. The order amends three prior orders granted to Chase that permit Chase subsidiaries in Malaysia, Mexico, and Russia to maintain in those countries certain assets of U.S. registered investment companies. The order substitutes Chemical (which anticipates changing its name to The Chase Manhattan Bank) as the party to which relief is granted following Chemical's anticipated merger with Chase. (Rel. SAFECO LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued to SAFECO Life Insurance Company (SAFECO), SAFECO Separate Account C, SAFECO Securities, Inc., Princor Financial Services Corporation, and Principal Marketing Services, Inc. pursuant to Section 11(a) of the Investment Company Act approving the terms of an offer of exchange of interests in certain variable annuity contracts issued by Principal Mutual Life Insurance Company for variable annuity contracts issued by SAFECO. (Rel. IC-22010 - June 11)

BLUE CHIP VALUE FUND, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Blue Chip Value Fund, Inc., under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 19(b) of the Act and Rule 19b-1 thereunder. The order permits applicant to make up to four distributions of long-term capital gains in any one taxable year, so long as applicant maintains in effect a distribution policy calling for quarterly distributions of a fixed percentage of its net asset value. (Rel. IC-22011 - June 11)

ITT HARTFORD LIFE AND ANNUITY INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 8 to request a hearing on an application filed by ITT Hartford Life and Annuity Company (ILA), ICMG Registered Variable Life Separate Account One (Separate Account), and Hartford Equity Sales Company for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from Section 27(c)(2) of the Act and Rule 6e-3(T)(c)(4)(v) thereunder. The order would permit the Separate Account and any separate accounts established in the future by ILA to support certain group flexible premium variable life insurance policies to deduct from premium payments received an amount that is reasonably related to the increased federal tax burden of ILA resulting from the application of Section 848 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-96-19) that would amend the Uniform Application for Securities Industry Registration or Transfer, Form U-4, and the Uniform Termination Notice for Securities Industry Registration, Form U-5. The revised forms define how information will be collected and stored in the revised Central Registration Depository (CRD). Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 10. (Rel. 34-37289)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-96-21) that would require NASD members to file electronically Forms U-4, U-5, and BD and amendments thereto. These amendments also establish time periods for when such filings must be made. The filing is part of a redesign effort to improve the Central Registration Depository (CRD) and to move toward total electronic filing of registration-related forms. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 10. (Rel. 34-37291)

MBS Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-MBSCC-96-01) that will modify MBSCC participants' deposit requirements to the participants fund to satisfy obligations arising from services rendered by MBSCC to its participants. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 17. (Rel. 34-37294)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-NSCC-96-05) that amends NSCC rules related to the Automated Customer Account Transfer service to facilitate account transfers of shares purchased in an initial public offering. (Rel. 34-37290)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-96-12) to reduce several NSCC fees. The proposed rule change became effective upon filing with the Commission. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 10. (Rel. 34-37293)
