COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

U.S.-RUSSIAN JOINT COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL COOPERATION

On July 16, Vice President Gore and Prime Minister Chernomyrdin announced the formation of a U.S.-Russia Capital Markets Forum. The Forum will play a key advisory role to the Russian government on the development of the Russian capital markets.

The Forum, chaired by U.S. Treasury Secretary Rubin, U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission Chairman Levitt, First Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Government Kadannikov, and Russian Federal Commission on the Capital Market Chairman Vasiliev, is intended to meet Prime Minister Chernomyrdin's request to Vice President Gore for expanded cooperation in the development of the Russian capital markets. It will operate under the auspices of the Gore-Chernomyrdin Commission and report periodically on its progress to Vice President Gore and Prime Minister Chernomyrdin.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE AND CEASE-AND-DESIST PROCEEDINGS FILED AGAINST INVESTMENT ADVISER FOR FAILURE TO DISCLOSE UNFAIR ALLOCATION PRACTICES

The Commission announced the institution of administrative and cease and desist proceedings against McKenzie Walker Investment Management, Inc. (McKenzie Walker), a registered investment adviser, and Richard C. McKenzie, Jr. (McKenzie), a co-founder of McKenzie Walker and its sole director, officer and shareholder.

The Commission found that McKenzie Walker and McKenzie failed to disclose to clients and prospective clients that McKenzie Walker allocated profitable equity trades and hot IPOs in an unfair and inequitable manner. The adviser favored clients that paid it a fee based on the account's performance and disfavored clients that paid a fee based on a percentage of assets under management. As a result of the undisclosed favoritism shown to performance-based fee clients, McKenzie Walker's fees were increased by approximately \$224,683 during a 14 month period. The Commission found that McKenzie Walker and McKenzie violated Section 206(2) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (Advisers Act). McKenzie Walker and McKenzie consented, without admitting or denying the findings, to the entry of an order censuring them; ordering them to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation or future violation of Section 206(2) of the Advisers Act; requiring McKenzie Walker to disgorge \$224,683 plus prejudgment interest; and imposing a civil penalty of \$100,000. COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST FORMER DIRECTOR OF AUTOMATED TELEPHONE MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS, INC.

The Commission announced that on July 16 it filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas seeking a permanent injunction and civil penalty against Earl V. Young, a former director of Automated Telephone Management Systems, Inc. (ATM).

The complaint alleged that Young knew, or was reckless in not knowing, that ATM's financial statements, for fiscal 1993 were materially misstated. The materially misstated financials were included in an annual report on Form 10-K for 1993, filed with the Commission on January 13, 1994. Specifically, the Commission alleged that Young knew that ATM had prematurely recognized revenue from a sale and signed ATM's Form 10-K for fiscal 1993. Young, a member of ATM's audit committee, also failed to notify ATM's independent auditors of the improper revenue recognition.

Without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, Young consented to the entry of a judgment against him, permanently enjoining Young from committing future violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-2 thereunder, and ordering Young to pay a civil money penalty in the amount of \$15,000.

The Commission previously sought and obtained permanent injunctions against ATM and three former ATM officers (LR-14710). [SEC v. Earl V. Young, Civil Action No. 3-96CV1985-T, N.D. Texas] (LR-14981; AAE Rel. 803)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FIRST FUNDS AND FIRST TENNESSEE BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION

An order has been issued on an application filed by FIRST FUNDS and First Tennessee Bank National Association under Sections 6(c), 10(f), and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Sections 10(f) and 17(a) of the Act. The order permits certain portfolios of FIRST FUNDS to purchase Tennessee tax-exempt securities from the Bond Division of First Tennessee Bank National Association (Bond Division) when such securities are underwritten solely by the Bond Division or when the Bond Division is a member of an underwriting syndicate, and from a syndicate manager when such securities are designated as group sales. The order also permits the portfolios to purchase Tennessee tax-exempt securities under Rule 10f-3 in amounts up to the greater of 10% or \$1,000,000, but in no event more than 15%, of a class of an issue, and from an underwriting syndicate of which the Bond Division is a member without limiting the consideration paid by a Portfolio in any one offering. GEORGE BAUM EMPLOYEE EQUITY FUND, L.P.

An order has been issued under Sections 6(b) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by George K. Baum Employee Equity Fund, L.P. The order grants the Fund an exemption from all provisions of the Act except Section 9, certain provisions of Sections 17 and 30, and Sections 36 through 53. The Fund is an employees' securities company within the meaning of Section 2(a)(13) of the Act. (Rel. IC-22071 - July 15)

PACIFIC HORIZON FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by Pacific Horizon Funds, Inc., et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would exempt applicants from Section 12(d)(1)(A)(ii), under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) exempting applicants from Sections 17(a)(1) and 17(a)(2), and under Rule 17d-1 to permit certain transactions in accordance with Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1. The order would also permit certain funds to use their cash reserves to purchase shares of affiliated money market funds. (Rel. IC-22072 - July 15)

QUALIVEST FUNDS, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to permit certain investment companies and certain private accounts to deposit their uninvested cash balances in one or more joint trading accounts to be used to enter into short-term investments. (Rel. IC-22073 - July 16)

AETNA SERIES FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 12 to request a hearing on an application filed by Aetna Series Fund, Inc. (Fund), et al. for an order under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit Aetna International Growth Fund, a series of the Fund, to acquire substantially all of the assets of the Aetna Asian Growth Fund, another series of the Fund. Because of certain affiliations, the two series may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-22074 - July 16)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>National</u> <u>Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-96-21) that amends the NASD By-Laws and Membership and Registration Rules to require electronic filing of Forms U-4, U-5, and BD. (Rel. 34-37439)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-96-07) filed by <u>The Depository Trust Company</u>. The proposed rule change modifies certain provisions of the Fund/SERV Interface Agreement with the National Securities Clearing Corporation in accordance with the conversion to same-day funds settlement. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> during the week of July 22. (Rel. 34-37440)
