ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

TRADING SUSPENSION IN GLOBAL TIMBER CORPORATION

The Commission announced, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), the temporary suspension of over-the-counter trading of the securities of Global Timber Corporation (Global), a Nevada corporation currently ladquartered at 4275 Executive Square, Suite 1040, La Jojia, California for a ten business day period commencing at 9:30 a.m. (EDT) on August 19, 1996, and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on August 30, 1996.

Trading has been suspended in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, Global's financial condition.

EMERGENCY INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST MATT MATSON AND HOME LINK COMPANIES

On July 29, the Commission filed an emergency injunctive action against the Home Link Corporation (Home Link), Home Link of Florida, Inc. (Home Link-FL), Home Link of Nevada, Inc. (Home Link-NV) (collectively, Home Link Companies) and Matt Matson (Matson) of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, alleging violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of stock of the Home Link Companies.

On July 31, the Honorable Stanley Marcus of the Southern District of Florida entered a temporary restraining order against Home Link, Home Link-FL, Home Link-NV and Matt Matson. The order restrained defendants from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Court also froze defendants' assets and ordered them to preserve their records and render an accounting.

On August 2, the Court appointed William Nortman of Miami, Florida, as receiver for the Home Link Companies. On August 7, the Honorable Edward Davis entered a preliminary injunction, with Matson's and the Home Link Companies' consent, preliminarily enjoining them from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SPECIAL OPPORTUNITIES TRUST, HEALTH CARE SECURITIES, SERIES I

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by Special Opportunities Trust, Health Care Securities, Series I for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. 1C-22144 - August 15)

GE INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT INCORPORATED, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by GE Investment Management Incorporated, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 12(d)(3) of the Act, and under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) aid the Act. The order would permit

applicants to create a "fund of funds," whereby the series of GE LifeStyle Funds would allocate substantially all of their assets among the series of GE Funds. (Rel. IC-22145 - August 15)

ALLIED CAPITAL LENDING CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by Allied Capital Lending Corporation, et al. for an order under Sections 6(c), 57(a)(4), 57(c), and 57(i) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder and under Section 12(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The requested order would permit, among other things, Allied Capital Lending to form two new subsidiaries and engage in certain joint transactions, modified asset coverage requirements for one of the subsidiaries individually and Allied Capital Lending and its subsidiaries on a consolidated basis, and Allied Capital Lending and its subsidiaries to file Exchange Act reports on a consolidated basis. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-96-22) to extend the effectiveness of Rule 103A, Specialist Stock Reallocation, until September 10, 1997. The proposal will be published in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 19. (Rel. 34-37564)

The Philadelphia Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHILADEP-96-11) to modify its procedures for the destruction of certain expired securities certificates. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 19. (Rel. 34-37570)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO OPTIONS DISCLOSURE DOCUMENT

The Commission approved proposed amendments (ODD-96-1) by the Canadian Derivatives Clearing Corporation to its options disclosure document. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 19. (Rel. 34-3/569; 15-1014)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Philadelphia Depository Trust Company</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHILADEP-96-12), which became effective upon filing, to permit Philadep participants to access Philadep's legal deposit processing services through the Philanet participant terminal system. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 19. (Rel. 34-37571)

A proposed rule change filed by <u>The Chicago Stock Exchange</u> to update certain references and citations in CHX rules relating to limited partnership rollups, depository eligibility requirements and Nasdaq/NM securities (SR-CHX-96-23) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 19. (Rel. 34-37576)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> (SR-Phlx-96-18) to change the exercise style of the National Over-the-Counter Index option from American-style to European-style. (Rel. 34-37575)

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission received a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-96-55) filed by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> seeking permanent approval of a system that monitors news announcements pertaining to underlying securities after the close of trading in the primary market for the underlying securities, and automatically suspends the Exchange's automatic execution system in options on securities that are the subject of such announcements. The Commission is granting accelerated approval to the portion of the proposal requesting a continuation of the pilot pending review of the request for permanent approval. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 19. (Rel. 34-37577)
