RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

EXPANSION OF SHORT-FORM REGISTRATION TO INCLUDE COMPANIES WITH NON-VOTING COMMON EQUITY

The Commission proposed for public comment amendments to rules and Forms S-3 and F-3 under the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) that would expand the availability of short-form registration by including non-voting common equity in the required public float.

Conforming changes were also proposed to the calculation of public float in Forms F-2 and 10-KSB and to the definition of "small business issuer" in Securities Act Rule 405, Item 10 of Regulation S-B, and Rule 12b-2 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST JAMES ZIMMERMAN AND OLD NAPLES SECURITIES, INC.

On August 28, the Commission filed a complaint against James Zimmerman of Naples, Florida, and Old Naples Securities, Inc., a Florida corporation located in Naples, Florida, seeking injunctive and other relief based on violations of the antifraud, net capital and books and records provisions of the federal securities laws.

The complaint alleged that Zimmerman and Old Naples, during the period from in or about July 1992 to in or about August 5, 1996, received in excess of \$3.5 million dollars from investors by misrepresenting to prospective investors that, among other things, their funds had been or were to be used to purchase securities, when, in fact, no securities were purchased and the funds had been misappropriated and/or used to pay previous investors and personal expenses. The complaint also alleged that Old Naples effected transactions in, or induced or attempted to induce the purchase and sale of securities at a time when Old Naples did not have and did not maintain the required minimum net capital to legally transact a securities business.

The Commission's action was combined with an application for a protective decree by the Securities Investor Protection Corporation (SIPC) and the appointment of a SIPC Trustee for Old Naples pursuant to Sections 5(b)(1) and 5(b)(3) of the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FIRST AMERICAN INVESTMENT FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by First American Investment Funds, Inc., et al. under Rule 17d-1 of the Investment Company Act. The requested order would permit an affiliated person of certain investment companies to receive a fee for acting as lending agent for the companies' portfolio securities. (Rel. THE JEFFERSON FUNDS TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Jefferson Funds Trust for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22182 - August 28)

GE FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by GE Funds, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 12(d)(1), under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act that would grant an exemption from Section 17(a), and pursuant to Rule 17d-1 under the Act to permit certain transactions in accordance with Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1. The order would permit certain investment companies to purchase shares of an affiliated unregistered investment company for cash management purposes. (Rel. IC-22183 - August 28)

NODDINGS INVESTMENT TRUST

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Noddings Investment Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22184 - August 28)

CONNECTICUT GENERAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by Connecticut General Life Insurance Company (CG Life), CG Corporate Insurance Variable Life Separate Account 02 (Account 02), and CIGNA Financial Advisors, Inc. Applicants seek an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from Section 27(c)(2) of the Act and Rule 6e-3(T)(c)(4)(v) thereunder, to the extent necessary to permit Account 02 and any other separate account established in the future by CG Life to support certain flexible premium variable life insurance contracts (Current Contracts) or

contracts which are substantially similar in all material respects to the Current Contracts to deduct from premium payments received a charge that is reasonable in relation to CG Life's increased federal income tax burden resulting from the application of Section 848 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. ALLSTATE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Allstate Life Insurance Company of New York (Company), Allstate Life of New York Separate Account A (Variable Account), and Allstate Life Financial Services, Inc. (collectively, Applicants) from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. Applicants are permitted to deduct a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Variable Account under certain flexible premium deferred variable annuity certificates (Contracts) and any contracts offered in the future (Future Contracts) by the Company which are substantially similar in all material respects to the Contracts; and the assets of any other variable accounts established in the future by the Company, in connection with the offer and sale of Future Contracts. The order extends the exemptions to any broker-dealer which may serve in the future as principal underwriter with respect to the Contracts or Future Contracts. (Rel. IC-22186 - August 28)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing New England Electric System to form one or more subsidiary companies in Vermont, Maine, and Connecticut to engage in wholesale marketing of electric power and to offer electrical-related services. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the retail marketing of electric power pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-26563)

HEC INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing HEC Inc. (HEC), a nonutility subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, and HEC's subsidiary companies, HEC Energy Consulting Canada Inc. and HEC International Corporation (collectively, Applicants), to expand the types of energy management, demand side management, consulting, and other energy-related services they provide to nonassociate and associate companies, and to finance and enter into joint ventures located York utilities outside New and New Jurisdiction has been reserved, pending completion of the record, over retail marketing of gas pending implementation by the relevant states of plans or programs permitting such activities; wholesale marketing and brokering of energy fuels outside the United States; constructing, owning, maintaining, and/or operating energy consuming

systems and related support equipment and structures, such as central heating and chilling plants, compressed air systems, energy management systems, pumps, motors, and lighting systems (but not systems for the generation of electric energy); and designing, constructing, and/or maintaining cogeneration and self-generation systems, up to 10 megawatts in capacity, outside the United States and Canada that will be owned and operated by associate and nonassociate companies, but will not be owned and operated by the Applicants. CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT CO.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Central Power and Light Company, a public-utility subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to incur obligations in connection with the issuance by Matagorda County Navigation District No. One in one or more series of up to \$374,365,000 in Pollution Control Revenue Bonds and to use interest rate swaps and other interest rate risk management devices.
