# ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

## TRADING SUSPENDED IN SECURITIES OF SYSTEMS OF EXCELLENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission today ordered the temporary suspension, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, of trading in the securities of Systems of Excellence, Inc. (SOE), beginning at 9:00 a.m. EDT on October 7, 1996 and concluding at 11:59 p.m. EDT on October 21, 1996. SOE is located in Coral Gables, Florida and Mclean, Virginia.

The Commission ordered this trading suspension because of questions raised as to the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things: (1) SOE's reported financial condition; (2) the existence and value of services rendered to SOE in exchange for stock issued by SOE; (3) whether stock was issued by SOE to consultants without registration; (4) the reasons for changes in SOE's independent accountants; and (5) SOE's sales of its video teleconferencing products. DECISION ORDERING THAT WILLIAM SOMDAHL BE BARRED FROM BEING ASSOCIATED WITH A BROKER OR DEALER, FROM PARTICIPATING IN AN OFFERING OF PENNY STOCK, AND FROM BEING ASSOCIATED WITH A MEMBER OF A NATIONAL SECURITIES EXCHANGE OR REGISTERED SECURITIES ASSOCIATION

The decision of an administrative law judge ordering that William Edwin Somdahl be barred from being associated with a broker or dealer, from participating in an offering of penny stock, and from being associated with a member of a national securities exchange or registered securities association has become final.

The law judge found that on October 4, 1994, the United States District Court for the District of Arizona found Somdahl to have violated Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 as well as Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The court enjoined Somdahl from further violations of these provisions of the securities laws and rule. The law judge noted that the district court's findings and injunction stemmed from Somdahl's involvement in an illegal scheme to sell unregistered, low priced, highly speculative securities, i.e., penny stocks, to customers. The law judge also noted that Somdahl was a substantial participant in the scheme as he was

involved in numerous instances of misconduct over an extended period of time and that Somdahl failed to acknowledge the wrongful nature of his actions. (Rel. 34-37785)

## DEFENDANT IN SEC ACTION PLEADS GUILTY

On October 3, Michael Tropiano of Haddonfield, New Jersey, pled guilty to a seventy count information charging him with mail fraud, securities fraud, commodities fraud and tax evasion, arising out of Tropiano's operation of a fraudulent investment scheme in non-existent commodity pools. Tropiano faces a maximum term of imprisonment of five years on each of the mail fraud, commodities fraud and tax evasion charges and a maximum term of imprisonment of ten years on the securities fraud charge, along with a maximum fine of approximately \$4.8 million. Sentencing has been scheduled for January 3, 1997.

The Securities and Exchange Commission and Commodity Futures Trading Commission filed a civil injunctive action in U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey on January 11, 1996, based on the same course of conduct alleged in the criminal action. Tropiano consented to the entry of a preliminary injunction enjoining him from engaging in violations of those provisions, freezing his personal assets as well as all investor funds in his possession or under his control, and ordering him to account for the use of investor funds. Tropiano had raised approximately \$2.9 million from investors. [U.S. v. Michael Tropiano, D.N.J.] (LR-15108)

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER REQUESTED IN SEC V. WESTERN EXECUTIVE GROUP, INC., ET AL.

On October 2, the Commission filed an emergency lawsuit in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, requesting a temporary restraining order prohibiting the offer and sale of investment contracts for the sale and leaseback of automated teller machines (ATMs) by Western Executive Group, Inc. (WEG), Cash Systems USA, Inc. (Cash Systems), Charles R. Rietz (Rietz), Robert R. Parrish (Parrish), Robert J. Struth (Struth) and R. Stephen Edgel (Edgel). The Commission also requested that the court appoint a temporary receiver over WEG and Cash Systems and freeze their assets.

The complaint alleges that the defendants violated Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, by engaging in the fraudulent offer and sale of interests in the ATM investment program. The defendants misrepresented the number of ATMs actually operating, the fact that the ATMs were not generating sufficient funds to pay investor returns and that the program was a Ponzi scheme. Rietz and Struth also failed to disclose their previous disciplinary history. The complaint also charges Parrish, Struth and Edgel with acting as

unregistered broker-dealers in violation of Section 15(a) of the Exchange Act. [Securities and Exchange Commission v. Western Executive Group, Inc., Cash Systems USA, Inc., Charles R.
