FINAL RULES CONCERNING PERIODIC REPORTING OF UNREGISTERED EQUITY SALES AND STREAMLINING DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO SIGNIFICANT BUSINESS ACQUISITIONS

On Wednesday, October 9, the Commission adopted rule and form changes designed to: (i) require registrants to report sales of equity securities that have not been registered under the Securities Act, including securities sold in reliance on Regulation S, Release No. 34-37801, and (ii) streamline registrant filing requirements with respect to financial statements of significant acquisitions, Release No. 33-7355. PROPOSED RULE CONCERNING OFFSHORE PRESS CONFERENCES, MEETINGS WITH COMPANY REPRESENTATIVES CONDUCTED OFFSHORE AND PRESS RELATED MATERIALS RELEASED OFFSHORE

On Wednesday, October 9, the Commission proposed rules designed to facilitate U.S. press access to offshore press activities. The rules would clarify the conditions under which journalists may be provided access to offshore press conferences, offshore press meetings and press related materials released offshore, where a present or proposed offering of securities or tender offer is discussed, without violating the provisions of Section 5 of the Securities Act, or the procedural requirements of the tender offer rules promulgated under the Williams Act, Release No. 33-7356. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

TRADING SUSPENSION ORDERED IN THE SECURITIES OF NOVATEK INTERNATIONAL, INC.

The Commission today announced the suspension of trading in the securities of Novatek International, Inc. from 9:30 a.m. EDT on October 15, 1996 until 11:59 EDT on October 28, 1996.

The Commission ordered this trading suspension because of questions raised as to the adequacy and accuracy of publicly-disseminated information about Novatek. This information concerns, among other things, Novatek's financial condition, including the valuation of certain assets reported on Novatek's financial statements. In light of these concerns, the Commission determined that the public interest and the protection of investors requires a suspension of trading in Novatek securities. (Rel. 34-37819)

PAUL PARSHALL BARRED

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings against Paul L. Parshall pursuant to Sections 15(b)(6), 17A(c)(4)(C) and 19(h) of the Exchange Act, Section 9(b) of the Investment Company Act and Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted an offer of settlement from Parshall in which he consented to the entry of an Order without admitting or denying the findings contained therein. The Order makes findings that willfully Parshall violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 by setting up a new Utah corporation, Republic International Corporation (New Republic), to assume the identity of a defunct Utah corporation with the same name While under Parshall's control New Republic (Old Republic). misrepresented itself to be Old Republic in filings with the Commission and in documents supplied to Old Republic's market makers.

The Commission ordered that Parshall be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, transfer agent, or municipal securities dealer and that Parshall be barred from participating in offerings of penny stock. (Rel. Nos. 34-37814; IA-1591; IC-22277)

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST JAMES FALLER II AND ROLAN COLON

On September 30, a complaint was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida against James S. Faller, II (Faller) of Augusta, Georgia and Rolan Colon (Colon) of Hialeah, Florida, alleging violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Commission is seeking permanent injunctions and disgorgement.

The complaint alleges that Faller and Colon, while consultants to Evro Corporation, caused Evro Corporation to issue a false press release on August 23, 1993. The false press release stated that Evro had obtained a \$30 million loan commitment to finance the development and sale of its products. The complaint alleges that Faller and Colon were to obtain the \$30 million loan for Evro. Further, it alleges that prior to the issuance of the false release, Faller and Colon, in violation of their fiduciary duty owed to Evro Corporation and its shareholders, while in possession of material non-public information, each purchased 20,000 shares of Evro common stock which they sold shortly after the issuance of the release at profits of over 40%. The complaint further alleges that no loan was ever made to Evro Corporation and that Faller and Colon knew no loan would be made to Evro Corporation by the purported lender. [SEC v. James S. JUDGMENTS ENTERED AGAINST CHARLES CHRISTOPHER AND FRANK ZITKEVITZ

The Commission announced that judgments of permanent injunction and other equitable relief were entered in United States District Court in Dallas, Texas, against Frank P. Zitkevitz (Zitkevitz) and Charles on Christopher (Christopher) October 3 and October respectively. Zitkevitz and Christopher consented to the entry of the judgments without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint that they violated Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Sections 9(a) and 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rules 10b-5 and 10b-6 thereunder, in a scheme to fraudulently promote, distribute, and manipulate the market for the securities of Environment Holdings, Inc., a "penny stock" company based in Dallas.

The Court also ordered Christopher to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$1,500,000, and Zitkevitz to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$237,711, plus prejudgment interest of \$100,252.88. Christopher's disgorgement amount was waived based on his demonstrated financial inability to pay, and the Court did not impose a civil money penalty based on his poor financial condition. Zitkevitz filed for protection under Chapter 7 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, and the Commission will seek to enforce the disgorgement judgment in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

VANGUARD MONEY MARKET RESERVES, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued pursuant to Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder giving interested persons until November 4 to request a hearing on an application filed by Vanguard Money Market Reserves, Inc., et al. to amend a prior order.

Applicants seek to amend an existing order that permitted applicants to operate a joint account that invests solely in repurchase agreements of seven days or less. The amended order would permit applicants to deposit uninvested cash into one or more joint accounts authorized to invest in repurchase agreements with maturities of up to 60 days as well as other short-term investments. A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, through direct and indirect subsidiaries, to engage in the wholesale marketing and brokering of energy commodities throughout the United States, and retail marketing of electric power and natural gas throughout the United States to the extent permitted by, and subject to compliance with, applicable state law.
