ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION ORDERS TRADING SUSPENSION IN SECURITIES OF OMNIGENE DIAGNOSTICS INC.

On November 20, the Commission announced that, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, it issued an order suspending trading in the securities of OmniGene Diagnostics, Inc. (ODI), a West Palm Beach, Florida-based company purportedly engaged in the business of providing DNA testing for the detection and management of periodontal disease. The order was issued because of questions regarding the accuracy of assertions by ODI, and by others, in documents sent to, and statements made to, market-makers of the stock of ODI, other broker-dealers, and to investors concerning, among other things, ODI's alleged ownership and other rights as to certain patents and trademarks, ODI's sales, past and projected, ODI's operations and facilities, and the number of freely traded shares of ODI common stock. Pursuant to the Commission's order, trading in the ODI securities was suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EST, November 20, 1996 through 11:59 p.m. EDT, on December 4, 1996. (Rel. 34-37966)

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST TERESA FERNANDEZ

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Teresa V. Fernandez, sole owner of Wharton Investments, Inc., formerly a registered investment adviser. The complaint charges violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and Sections 206(1), 206(2) and 206(4) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (Advisers Act). Without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, Fernandez consented to be permanently enjoined from violating these provisions. The complaint also seeks disgorgement, prejudgment interest and civil penalties.

The complaint alleges as follows. Beginning in 1990, Fernandez ensured that her clients would not receive brokerage statements revealing the true status of their accounts by submitting forged letters to Bear Stearns & Co. directing that the statements be sent to her own home. From September 1990 through March 1995, Fernandez distributed fake Bear Stearns statements that reported securities trades that had not in fact occurred in the accounts. These

statements, and Fernandez's own quarterly statements to clients, reported net equity that exceeded the true account balances by 50% to 90%. From December 1986 through September 1995, Fernandez misappropriated at least \$64,036,612 by submitting falsified Letters of Authorization directing that broker-dealers transfer client funds to accounts under Fernandez's own control. Fernandez distributed the misappropriated funds to various persons and entities, including her relatives and other advisory clients. Fernandez used certain of the funds to cover withdrawal requests that exceeded the true value of the pertinent client accounts. Fernandez also improperly charged her advisory clients at least \$1,500,568 in performance fees, and violated certain custody requirements under the Advisers Act. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WANGER ADVISORS TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by Wanger Advisors (Trust) and Wanger Asset Management, L.P. (Adviser). Applicants seek an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder. The order would permit shams of any current of future series of the Trust and shares of any other investment company that is offered as a funding medium for variable insurance products, and for which the Adviser or any of its affiliates may serve now or in the future as manager, investment adviser, administrator, principal underwriter or sponsor, to be sold to and held by variable annuity and variable life insurance company separate accounts of both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies; and qualified pension and retirement plans outside the separate account context. THE CLASSIC TRUST

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that The Classic Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22342 - November 19)

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a gas registered holding company, to invest up to an aggregate amount of \$75 million in three individual foreign gas pipeline projects. (Rel. 35-26608; IS-1029)
