ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC FILES SETTLED CEASE AND DESIST PROCEEDING AGAINST NATIONAL STEEL CORPORATION BASED UPON IMPROPER ACCOUNTING FOR RESERVES

On March 29, the Commission filed a settled admiritrative proceeding against National Steel Corporation, a steel manufacturer headquartered in Mishawaka, Indiana, for violations that resulted from booking excessive reserves and from improperly releasing those reserves to income in later periods. Without admitting or denying the findings therein, National Steel consented to the issuance of a Commission Order which finds that National Steel allowed numerous liability accrual and asset allowance accounts to become overaccrued by approximately \$51 million as of 1997 Further, once National Steel discovered the overaccrued reserves, it did not adjust the accounts in conformity with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles Instead, National Steel's former controller and vice president of finance ordered the reserves to be reduced gradually, by taking even dollar amounts from the reserves into income over several reporting periods, without disclosing these adjustments to the public The overaccrued reserves caused National Steel's balance sheets to be materially false and misleading for the years 1992 through 1996, and the undisclosed gradual reductions of the reserves caused National Steel's income statements to be materially false and misleading for certain quarters in 1996 and 1997 In 1998, National Steel restated its financial statements for the years 1992 through the second quarter of 1997 The Commission ordered National Steel to cease and desist from violating the reporting, books and records and internal controls provisions of the federal securities laws [cections 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A) and 13(b)(2)(B) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder] (Rel. 34-44130, AAE Rel 1378, File No. 3-10446)

MICHAEL KEATING AND KEATING ADVISORY GROUP SANCTIONED FOR VIOLATING ANTIFRAUD PROVISIONS

On March 29, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Public Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Michael P. Keating and Keating Advisory Group, an investment advisory firm registered with the Commission Both are residents of Maryland Keating and Keating Advisory Group consented to the entry of the Commission's Order without admitting or denying the findings contained therein.

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The Commission, in its Order, found that from November 1996 through July 1997, Andrew P. Bodnar and another individual directed a fraudulent scheme through which they, together with other sales representatives, raised approximately \$6.4 million from the sale of unregistered securities in CBT Holding Corporation and CBT-Ohio Ltd to at least 148 public investors. The investors were told that their funds would be used to purchase low-risk financial instruments. However, Bodnar misappropriated most of the funds to pay for his business and personal expenses.

During this period, Keating, through Keating Advisory Group, sold at least \$3 million of CBT and CBT-Ohio securities to 69 investors. As part of his sales efforts, Keating made material misrepresentations about the nature of, and the degree of risk inherent in, investments in CBT and CBT-Ohio. Specifically, he told many investors that their funds would be invested in certificates of deposit secured by a "world bank." He also either expressly told or led investors to believe that the 12 percent rate of return was "guaranteed" and/or "backed by the full faith and credit of the United States" However, Keating either knew or was reckless in not knowing that these statements were false. In this regard, he failed to review even the most basic documentation regarding the financial conditions of these companies even though he knew that Bodnar intended to use some of the proceeds from investments in CBT and CBT-Ohio to repay investors in another failed venture which Bodnar had sponsored

The Commission also found that Keating and Keating Advisory Group consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint, to the entry of an order by the District Court for the Northern District of Ohio enjoining them from future violations of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Section 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 16b-5 thereunder

On the basis of its findings, Keating's and Keating Advisory Group's Offer of Settlement and the entry of the injunction referenced above, the Commission ordered that (i) Keating be barred from association with any broker, dealer or investment adviser; and (ii) the registration of Keating Advisory Group be revoked. SEC SUES SEAN ST. HEART FOR INTERNET FRAUD

On March 29, the Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia alleging that Sean E. St. Heart, age 25, engaged in an illegal cyber smear by posting a false message about NCO Group, Inc. on the Yahoo! Finance

Internet message board St. Heart's message had a dramatic impact on NCO's stock price, causing its market capitalization to drop by over \$200 million.

The Commission's complaint specifically alleges that on Friday night, December 3, 1999, St Heart posted a false message on Yahoo! in which he claimed that he, as the President and CEO of St Heart Productions, together with twelve other companies, had prepared a \$20 million lawsuit against NCO for its "business practices" The message was false in that St. Heart (1) had not prepared such a lawsuit, (2) had not joined with any other company in connection with such a lawsuit, and (3) had no basis to claim that he had been damaged in the amount of \$20 million.

The complaint alleges that on the same day, St. Heart received a telephone call about an unpaid debt from someone engaged by NCO, a public company engaged in accounts receivable management services. Several hours after he received that call, St. Heart posted his fraudulent message with the knowledge, or reckless disregard of the fact, that the message would materially impact NCO's stock price

The complaint alleges that St Heart's message had a dramatic impact on NCO's stock price. Over the next two trading days, NCO's stock price dropped \$12,3/16, or 28 percent, to \$34,5/16 from its closing price of \$46.5 '6 on Friday, December 3, 1999, representing a loss of over \$200 million of NCO's market capitalization. NCO's trading volume also surged to 2.9 million shares on December 7, 1999 — representing a ninefold increase relative to the average three-month daily volume.

Simultaneously with the filing of the Commission's complaint, St Heart, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, consented to the entry of a judgment permanently enjoining him from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws – Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder St Heart further consented to the entry of a judgment that waives the imposition of a monetary penalty based on his demonstrated inability to pay [SEC v Sean Edward St Heart, Civ Action No 01-CV-00695, TPJ, D D C] (LR-16947A)
