RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

COMMISSION PUBLISHES TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS TO INTERNATIONA' DISCLOSURE STANDARDS

On June 11, the Commission issued a release adopting technical amendments to Form 20-F under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and to Forms F-2 and F-3 u er the Securities A 2 of 1933. The amendments to the forms clarify the requirements regarding the age of financial statements, codify the long-standing practice of acce two years audited income statement and statement of cash flows information if the financial statements are presented in accordance with U.S. Generally Accepted Accounting Principles, and correct cross-references in Form 20-F and Forms F-2 and F-3. The changes clarify language that could create confusion and do not alter the current requirements for companies filing on the forms. (Rels. 33-7983; 34-44406)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION INSTITUTES ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING AGAINST CHARLES HAGEMANN

On June 13, the Commission instituted a public administrative proceeding gainst Charles F. Hagemann (Hagemann) pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously with the institution of this proceeding, Hagemann submitted an Offer of Settlement in which, while neither admitting nor penying the Commission's findings, Hagemann consented to the entry of an Order barring him from association with any broker or dealer, with a right to apply after one year. The Order was based on the entry of a permanent injunction in a civil action against Hagemann. The Commission's complaint alleged that Hagemann violated the registration and antifraud provisions by, among other things, omitting to disclose the actual commissions paid to him in connection with the offer and sale of the unregistered securities of two restaurant subsidiaries of Papa Holdings, Inc., a company based in Los Angeles, California. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASE

AETNA LIFE INSURANCE AND ANNUITY COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 9, 2001 to request a hearing on an application filed by Aetna Life Insurance and Annuity Company (ALIAC) and its Variable Annuity Account B (VAB), Aetna Insurance Company of Americal (AICA), Golden American Life Insurance Company (Golden) and its Separate Account B (Account B), First Golden American Life Insurance Company of New Y First Golden), Reliastar Life Insurance of New York (Reliastar), Directed Services, Inc. (DSI), and Washington Square Securities, Inc. (WSS). Applicants seek an order under Section 6 (c), of the Investment Company Act to amend an existing order (Rel. IC-24649, dated September 20, 2000, File No. 812-12098) to add Golden, Account B, First Golden, Reliastar, DSI and WSS as parties to the existing order. In addition, applicants request that the order extend to any National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. member broker-dealer controlling or controlled by, or under common control with any applicant, whether existing or created in the future, that serves as a distributor or principal underwriter of such contracts. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-2001-23) by the C^Licago Board Options Exchange to make its brokers' blanket bond requirements similar to those of other self-regulatory organizations has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 11. (Rel. 34-44401)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed with the Commission a propositive change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-2001-36) to eliminate the ACT Service Desk feature. Publication of the notice in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the week of June 11. (Rel. 34-44411)
