ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION AFFIRMS NASD DISCIPLINE AGAINST COMPLIANCE OFFICER FOR FAILURE TO COOPERATE WITH NASD INFORMATION REQUESTS

On October 19, the Commission affirmed the discipline imposed by the NASD on Robert Fitzpatrick, formerly the Compliance Officer of SFI Investments, Inc (SFI). Despite repeated NASD requests, it took Fitzpatrick more than five months to provide documents requested by the NASD in connection with an investigation of SFI. The NASD censured Fitzpatrick, fined him \$2500, and suspended him in all capacities for five business days. In affirming the NASD's sanctions, the Commission t_{sc} ected Fitzpatrick's argument that the NASD's sanctions were excessive and oppressive. (Rel. 34-44956; File No. 3-9932r)

LEONARD GREER CONSENTS TO BAR FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY BROKER OR DEALER, BASED ON HIS ROLE IN MARKET MANIPULATION

On October 19, the Commission settled an administrative proceeding against Leonard B. Greer of Rye, New York, for engaging in a fraudulent market manipulation scheme. In the proceeding, previously instituted on July 24, 2001, Greer consented to the entry of an order that bars him from association with any broker or dealer.

The order contains the following findings, which were not admitted or denied by Greer. The Commission filed a Complaint against Greer charging that, from January 1994 through April 1994, Greer fraudulently manipulated the market price of the stock of AFGL International, Inc. from \$1 to \$7 per share (SEC v. Greer, et al., SDNY). The complaint alleged that Greer accomplished the manipulation by controlling the supply of AFGL stock that was available to the market; by accumulating over two-thirds of the freely-tradable AFGL stock in the proprietary account of Greer's firm, L.C. Wegard & Co.; by exerting price leadership to increpent the market price of AFGL stock; and by generating retail demand for AFGL stock. The complaint further alleged that, during an intensive nine-day selling effort that began on April 20, 1994, Wegard, sold over 1 million shares of AFGL stock to its customers, at artificially inflated prices, netting a profit of approximately \$3.5 million.

Greer admitted the following findings also contained in the order. On June 5, 2001, in SEC v. Greer, et al., the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York issued an order enjoining Greer from violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Sections 10(b), 13(d)(1) and 13(d)(2) of the Exchange Act and Rules 13d-1 and 13d-2 promulgated thereunder. In 1998, the Commission previously suspended Greer for one year from association with any broker or dealer, barred him from participating in any offering of penny stock, and revoked the broker-dealer registration of Wegard, based on findings that they engaged in the fraudulent mark⁻⁺ manipulation of the registered common stock of Of Counsel Enterprises, Inc. (In the Matter of F.N. Wolf & Co., Inc., et al.). (Rel. 34-44959; File No. 3-10538)

DEFAULT JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST ROBERT GERWIN IN CONNECTION WITH PRIME BANK OFFERING

The Commission announced the entry of a default judgment in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida against Robert E. Gerwin of Cincinnati, Ohio. The Commission's complaint alleged that Gerwin acted as a sales agent for Earl A. Abbott, a Titusville, Florida businessman by selling \$300,000 of non-existent prime bank securities to investors. Gerwin, the Commission alleged, entered into a joint venture agreement promising the investors a weekly return of 16% over forty weeks, or 640%. The Commission alleged there were no bank debentures, no trading and that, as a result of Gerwin's actions, investors lost \$245,000.

The Court entered a Permanent Injunction prohibiting Gerwin from violating the securities registration, antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the Securities Act and the Exchange Act. The Commission did not allege that Gerwin received any sales commission or profits and according the Commission did not seek disgorgement. However, the Commission sought imposition of civil monetary penalties against Gerwin and the Court entered an order requiring Gerwin to pay a monetary penalty of \$50,000. [SEC v. Earl A. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ISHARES, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by iShares, Inc., et al. permitting an open-end management investment company, whose portfolios will consist of the component securities of certain equity securities indices, to issue shares of limited redeemability that will trade in the secondary market at negotiated prices. The order also permits certain affiliated persons of the portfolios to deposit securities into, and receive securities from, the portfolios. The order also permits certain portfolios to pay redemption proceeds more than seven days after the tender of shares of the portfolios for redemption. (Rel. IC-25215 – October 18)

WNC HOUSING TAX CREDIT FUND VI, L.P., SERIES 9 AND SERIES 10, AND WNC & ASSOCIATES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 9, 2001, to request a hearing on an application filed by WNC Housing Tax Credit Fund VI, L.P., Series 9 and Series 10 (Series), and WNC & Associates, Inc. for an order under Sections 6(c) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 (...t) exempting each Series from all provisions of the Act, except Sections 37 through 53 of the Act and the rules and regulations under those Sections. The order would permit each Series to invest in limited partnerships that engage in the ownership and operation of apartment complexes for low and moderate income persons. (Rel. IC-25216 – October 19)

EVERGREEN SELECT FIXED INCOME TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 16, 2001, to request a hearing on an application filed by Evergreen Select Fixed Income Trust, et al. for an order under (1) Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Sections 18(f) and 21(b) of the Act; (2) Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Act granting an exemption from Section 12(d)(1) of the Act; (3) Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act granting an exemption from Sections 17(a)(1) and 17(a)(3) of the Act; and (4) Section

17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 under the Act. The order would permit certain registered open-end management investment companies to participate in a joint lending and borrowing facility. (Rel. IC-25217 – October 22)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HOLYOKE WATER POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 13, 2001, to request a hearing on a proposal by Holyoke Water Power Company (HWP), an electric utility company subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, a registered public utility holding company, and Holyoke Power and Electric Company, a wholly owned subsidiary of HWP, to sell certain generation, distribution, and related assets as part of a litigation settlement agreement with the City of Holyoke Gas and Electric Department. NISOURCE INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 13, 2001, to request a hearing on a proposal by NiSource Inc. (NiSource), a registered holding company, its ten utility subsidiaries, and certain of its nonusery subsidiaries to establish and participate in a new money pool that will replace an existing money pool, and to authorize Columbia Gas of Maryland, Inc., a public utility subsidiary company of NiSource, to issue additional shares of its common stock and long-term debt securities to the Columbia Energy Group, a subsidiary registered holding company of NiSource. AMENDMENTS TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> has filed Amendments 3, 4, and 5 to a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-00-02) amending the NASD Code of Arbitration rules relating to injunctive relief. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 22. (Rel. 34-44950)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> (SR-BSE-2001-01) regarding the trading of Nasdaq securities on the floor of the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u>, pursuant to unlisted trading privileges, has been granted accelerated approval under Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> during the week of October 22. (Rel. 34-44952)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>International Securities</u> <u>Exchange</u> (SR-ISE-2001-18), to establish priority and order handling principles for complex orders, such as spreads, straddles, and other multi-legged transactions, under Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 22. (Rel. 34-44955)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change was filed by the <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> to allow NSCC to add a new membership category to its rules (Data Services Only Member) (SR-NSCC-2001-14). The proposed rule change, which became effective upon filing, allows NSCC to allow Data Services Only Members to use certain non-clearing services available at NSCC. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> during the week of October 22. (Rel. 34-44960)
