COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC ANNOUNCES MOU AND PROTOCOL TO FORMALIZE COOPERATIVE RELATIONSHIP WITH RUSSIAN FEDERAL COMMISSION ON SECURITIES AND THE CAPITAL MARKET

The Commission today released a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and a Protocol signed with the Federal Commission on Securities and the Capital Market of the Government of the Russian Federation (FCSCM). The purpose of the MOU is to provide for mutual enforcement assistance relating to activities in the U.S. and Russian securities markets. It also establishes a framework for the SEC to provide technical assistance for the development of the Russian securities markets. The Protocol sets forth the priority areas for technical assistance that the SEC contemplates providing to the FCSCM and the manner in which the SEC will provide such assistance. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION IMPOSES SANCTIONS AGAINST RICHARD ANDERS

The Commission has issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Richard A. Anders (Anders), formerly associated with First Alliance Securities, Inc. (First Alliance), a now defunct penny stock broker-dealer headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia. The Commission accepted Anders's Offer of Settlement in which, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, except for findings that he was associated as an unregistered stockbroker with First Alliance from May 1989 to August 1989, and that on October 27, 1995, he was convicted, among other things, of securities fraud, Anders consented to be barred from associating with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company, and from participating in an offering of penny stock. The counts of the indictment of which Anders was convicted alleged, among other things, that he misrepresented to customers that large profits would be made by investing in penny stocks promoted by First Alliance, executed trades in customers' accounts without the customers' authorization, failed to place proceeds from the sale of a customer's stock into the customer's money market account as requested, and refused to execute a customer's order to sell stock unless he received 25 percent of the sale proceeds. He was sentenced to fifty-one months imprisonment and restitution of \$2.5 million. (Rel. 34-36553)

CEASE AND DESIST PROCEEDINGS SETTLED AGAINST JOHN MCMILLAN

The Commission has settled administrative cease and desist proceedings entered on December 6 pursuant to the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), against John McMillan (McMillan). The Order Making Findings and Imposing a Cease and Desist Order (Order) found that during 1991, McMillan caused the Keith Group of Companies, Inc. (Keith Group) to violate Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1 and 13a-13, thereunder. The Order further found that McMillan facilitated Keith Group's reporting of gains in its May 31, 1991, Form 10-Q and its August 31, 1991, Form 10-K, by signing purchase contracts and promissory notes falsely attesting to his purported purchases of real estate from Keith Group. Pursuant to his Offer of Settlement, McMillan consented to entry of an order requiring him to cease and desist from causing any violations and any future violations of Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1 and 13a-13, thereunder. ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST H.F. LENFEST AND MARGUERITE LENFEST

On December 6, the Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania against H.F. Lenfest and Marguerite Lenfest. The complaint alleges that the Lenfests violated Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, seeks permanent injunctions, disgorgement of their ill-gotten gains plus prejudgment interest thereon, and civil penalties. H.F. Lenfest's alleged wrongful conduct stemmed from his recommendation to his son, Chase Lenfest, to purchase Tele-Communications, Inc. (TCI) stock. H.F. Lenfest, then a Liberty Media Corporation (Liberty) Board member, recommended this purchase while in possession of material, nonpublic information concerning Bell Atlantic's proposed merger with TCI and Liberty and in breach of his fiduciary duty to Liberty.

Marguerite Lenfest's alleged wrongful conduct stemmed from her misappropriation of material, nonpublic information concerning the proposed Bell Atlantic-TCI-Liberty merger and her direction to Chase Lenfest to purchase TCI stock for her account. [SEC v. Harold Fitzgerald Lenfest and Marguerite Lenfest, Civil Action No. 95-7597, JCJ, E.D. Pa.] (LR-14747) FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST KENNETH WIGGINS, JR. AND WIGGINS AND COMPANY, INC.

On December 4, the Honorable William L. Dwyer, United States District Court Judge for the Western District of Washington, entered a Final Judgment of Disgorgement, Prejudgment Interest and Civil Penalties against Kenneth Mitchell Wiggins, Jr. and Wiggins and Company, Inc. (Defendants) who consented, to the entry of the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. Pursuant to the Final Judgment, the Defendants will pay, jointly and severally, disgorgement of \$800,500 and prejudgment interest of \$631,895.12. Kenneth Mitchell Wiggins, Jr. must also pay civil penalties of \$180,500.00.

The Commission's complaint, filed September 30, 1994, alleged that from March 1987 through June 1992, Wiggins, through Wiggins & Co., raised about \$950,000 from 19 investors through sales of interests in nineteenth century Peruvian bonds. When soliciting investors, the Defendants misrepresented and failed to state material facts concerning the ownership and value of the bonds. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FIRST AMERICAN INVESTMENT FUNDS, INC. AND FIRST BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION

An order has been issued on an application filed by First American Investment Funds, Inc. (FAIF) and First Bank National Association under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act, and pursuant to Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder permitting the Stock Fund, a series of FAIF, to acquire all of the assets of the Limited Volatility Stock Fund, another series of FAIF. Because of certain affiliations, the two funds may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-21566 - December 5)

TORCHMARK INSURED TAX-FREE FUND, INC. TORCHMARK GOVERNMENT SECURITIES FUND, INC.

> Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Torchmark Insured Tax-Free Fund, Inc. and Torchmark Government Securities Fund, Inc. have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-21567 and IC-21568, respectively -December 5)

PCS CASH FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 2 to request a hearing on an application filed by PCS Cash Fund, Inc., et al. for an order that would permit each applicant investment company to enter into deferred compensation arrangements with its directors who are not interested persons of the company. EAI SELECT MANAGERS EQUITY FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 28 to request a hearing on an application filed by EAI Select Managers Equity Fund, et al. for an order pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act, and pursuant to Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder. The requested order would permit a collective investment account sponsored by EAI Partners, L.P. (EAI) to transfer its securities to an open-end management investment company (Fund) advised by a subsidiary of EAI. (Rel. IC-21570 - December 6)
