

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ARTHUR CARLSON AND ASSOCIATES AND ARTHUR CARLSON CITED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Arthur Carlson and Associates and Arthur Carlson (Respondents). Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Respondents' Offers of Settlement, wherein they consented to the Commission's Order Instituting Public Proceedings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions, without admitting or denying the allegations contained therein.

The Order finds that Respondents wilfully violated Sections 205(1), 206 and 207 of the Advisers Act and Rule 206(4)-3. The Commission suspended Respondents' from the investment advisory business for nine months and ordered them to send a disclosure letter to each of their clients notifying them of the instant action and enclosing a copy of the Commission's Order. The Commission also ordered Respondents to comply with certain undertakings, including requiring them to submit to an annual audit of compliance with the Advisers Act. (Rel. IA-947)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NARRAGANSETT CAPITAL CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 28 to request a hearing on an application by Narragansett Capital Corporation and Bevis Industries, Inc. for an order exempting from the provisions of Section 17(a) and permitting, under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1, a group of interrelated transactions consisting of the refinancing of indebtedness as well as other related agreements. NATIONWIDE MULTI-FLEX MONEY MARKET TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 31 to request a hearing on an application by Nationwide Multi-Flex Money Market Trust for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14302 - Jan. 4)

DREXEL SERIES TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 29 to request a hearing on an application by Drexel Series Trust for an order: exempting Drexel from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 22c-1 and 22d-1 to permit it to assess and, in certain cases, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on redemptions of its shares, and approving certain offers of exchange. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 28 to request a hearing on a proposal by Columbia Gas System, Inc. (Columbia), a registered holding company, together with its subsidiaries, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation and The Inland Gas Company, to enter into a transaction whereby Inland and Transmission would transfer all natural resource properties to Columbia Natural Resources, Inc. which will then become a subsidiary of Columbia. An order has been issued granting the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange to strike all put and call option contracts respecting the common stock of National Medical Care, Inc. (Rel. 34-21631)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-84-41) to amend Rule 950 to permit stop and stop limit option orders to be elected when the quoted market for the option reaches the appropriate bid or offer price. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of January 7. (Rel. 34-21629)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A rule change filed by the Midwest Securities Trust Company became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-MSTC-84-10) changes MSTC's interest and maturity cut-off date for bearer securities from ten business days prior to payment or maturity date to one calendar month prior to payment or maturity date. TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

PENNWALT CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 28 to request a hearing on an application by Pennwalt Corporation and First Pennsylvania Bank, N.A. under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 for an order declaring that the trusteeship of First Pennsylvania, under two existing indentures and a new indenture, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify First Pennsylvania from acting as trustee. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
