COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

DIVISION OF MARKET REGULATION TO HOST SECURITIES IMMOBILIZATION WORKSHOPS

> The Division of Market Regulation will host three Securities Immobilization Workshops on February 25 and 26, and March 8, 1985 beginning at 9:30 a.m. The workshops will be held in Room 1C30, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC, and are open to the public.

> The workshops are intended to provide financial industry representatives a forum to discuss increasing the issuance of securities in book-entry form and further immobilizing certificates for securities that continue to be certificated. The February 25 session will examine the advantages of book-entry systems and impediments to their use. The February 26 session will explore possibilities for certificate immobilization or book-entry issuance of securities exempt from registration under the securities laws, especially mortgage-backed securities, treasury receipts, municipal notes and commercial paper. The March 8 session will focus on problems faced by the insurance industry in using registered securities depositories, primarily State legal restrictions.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST MID-STATE SECURITIES CORP. AND NICHOLAS A. CODISPOTI

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Mid-State Securities Corp., a registered Red Bank, New Jersey broker-dealer, and its president, Nicholas A. Codispoti.

The Order for Public Proceedings alleges that Mid-State wilfully violated, and Codispoti wilfully aided and abetted violations of, certain Exchange Act rules relating to Amendments to Application, Hypothecation of Customers' Securities, Customer Protection, Recordkeeping, Financial Reporting, and Supplemental Financial Reporting, and the Fidelity Bonding Requirements and Customer Identification Information Rule of the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Nid-State and Codispoti are true, and if so, to decide what, if any, remedial action would be appropriate. (Rel. 34-21692) PERMANENT SUSPENSION OF REGULATION A EXEMPTION FOR WESTAR FINANCIAL, INC.

> The Commission ordered that the conditional exemption from registration provided by Regulation A claimed by Westar Financial, Inc., a Colorado corporation, be permanently suspended under Rule 261(a) of Regulation A. This Order permanently suspending the conditional exemption provides that the suspension is based upon alleged: false, misleading or inaccurate statements in a Form 2-A (Report Pursuant to Rule 260 of Regulation A) filed with the Commission on June 7, 1983 as the final report regarding sales under the Regulation A offering; inaccuracies in the "Plan of Distribution" set forth in the Regulation A offering circular; and failure by Westar's president to cooperate with the Commission's inquiry regarding this matter.

Westar submitted an Offer of Settlement after the conclusion of a two-day Administrative Hearing. In the Offer of Settlement, Westar consented to an Order containing certain findings and remedial sanctions without admitting or denying the Commission's findings. (Rel. 33-6565)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ML VENTURE PARTNERS I, L.P.

An order has been issued granting ML Venture Partners I, L.P., a business development company, and Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1984 an exemption from the provisions of Sections 17(d) and 57(a) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 permitting certain concurrent portfolio investments by ML and Merrill. NATIONWIDE MULTI-FLEX MONEY MARKET TRUST

An order has been issued declaring that Nationwide Multi-Flex Money Market Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14351 - Feb. 4)

E.I.P. FUNDING CORPORATION

An order has been issued exempting E.I.P. Funding Corporation from all provisions of the Investment Company Act to permit it to issue and sell bonds and loan the proceeds as part of the long-term financing of a bulk power transmission system of Public Service Company of New Mexico. (Rel. IC-14352 - Feb. 5)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 1 to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, NEES Energy, Inc. Applicants seek authorization for financing of NEES Energy through capital contributions and non-interest bearing loans by NEES not to exceed \$23 million, and guarantees by NEES to the extent required for NEES Energy to obtain performance and surety bonds in its business activities. (Rel. 35-23589 -Feb. 4)

APPALACHIAN POWER COMPANY

A supplemental notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 1 to request a hearing on a proposal by Appalachian Power Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to incur obligations under a pollution control facilities sales agreement with Mason County, West Virginia. Appalachian would incur obligations which run parallel to the County's obligations under a series of refunding bonds in the aggregate amount of \$30 million to be issued and sold by the County. The proceeds of these bonds will be used to refund maturing bonds. (Rel. 35-23590 -Feb. 5)

TRANSOK, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 1 to request a hearing on a proposal by Transok, Inc., subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to form a subsidiary to acquire a partnership interest in an interstate natural gas pipeline system. (Rel. 35-23591 - Feb. 5)

Proposed rule changes have been filed by: The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-85-2) to provide a surcharge to cover estimated expenses of NYSE member organizations in soliciting certain information from their customers who are beneficial owners of securities held in streeet name. (Rel. 34-21702); and The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated (SR-CBOE-85-3) to conduct a pilot program in six different individual stock options. The CBOE will maintain the existing guarterly expiration cycles for these six options and add a two-month option. (Rel. 34-21707)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-82-20) to permit NYSE specialists and their associated persons to use options on the specialists' specialty stocks for hedging purposes. (Rel. 34-21710)

SOUTHEAST BANKING CORPORATION
