### CLOSED MEETING - TUESDAY, MARCH 11, 1985 - 2:30 p.m.

The subject matter of the March 11 closed meeting will be: Formal orders of investigation; Institution of administrative proceedings of an enforcement nature; Institution of injunctive actions; Litigation matter.

OPEN MEETING - THURSDAY, MARCH 14, 1985 - 4:00 p.m.

The subject matter of the March 14 open meeting will be:

(1) Consideration of whether to propose for public comment amendments to Rule 6e-2 under the Investment Company Act of 1940. The amendments would conform certain parts of Rule 6e-2, the exemptive rule for insurance company separate accounts issuing scheduled premium variable life insurance, to Rule 6e-3(T), the exemptive rule for separate accounts issuing flexible premium variable life insurance. (2) Consideration of whether to propose for public comment: (a) new Form N-14 for the registration of securities issued by registered management investment companies and business development companies in business combination transactions; and (b) certain related rules for the filing and processing of the proposed form. (3) Consideration of whether to propose for public comment Rule 205-3 under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 which would permit registered investment advisers to charge their clients performance fees under certain conditions. (4) Consideration of an application filed by Alleghany Corporation (Applicant) requesting an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 temporarily exempting Applicant until June 30, 1985 from most of the provisions of the Act. The Applicant has also requested that, pending final action on its application, the Commission issue an interim temporary order granting the same exemptive relief pending a final determination on the application by the Commission. (5) Consideration of whether to declare the Americus Trust for Exxon Shares effective. On June 7, 1984, the Commission published for public comment a release soliciting written comments on wides raised by the Americus Trust. These offerings relate to units of a unit investment trust series whose portfolios would consist of common stock of major industrial issuers, and two separable components of such units. In addition, the Commission will consider whether to approve a proposed rule change of the American Stock Exchange establishing listing standards for Americus Trust type securities. REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY AGENDA AND RULES SCHEDULED FOR REVIEW

The Commission published, under the Regulatory Flexibility Act, an agenda of open and anticipated rulemaking actions, a listing of rules scheduled for review in the next 12 months, and a listing of completed rulemaking actions and reviews since the publication of the October 1984 agenda. The agenda, including the text of the individual entries, will be published in the <u>Federal Register</u> by April 30, 1985 as part of a government-wide Unified Agenda of Federal Regulations. The Commission seeks comment on the open or anticipated rulemaking actions and on the rules scheduled for review. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LEGG MASON TAX-EXEMPT TRUST, INC.
