CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

PHILIP H. PARSONS PLEADS GUILTY

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on February 27 U.S. District Court Judge Tom Stagg accepted a plea of guilty from Philip Harmon Parsons to two counts of criminal contempt. Sentencing has been set for April 5.

The criminal contempt charges were based on Parsons' violation of an order of permanent injunction entered on August 29, 1977 by the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Louisiana, Shreveport Division, in SEC v. Southwest Coal & Energy Co., Philip H. Parsons, et al. Parsons was, by that order, permanently enjoined from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Specifically, the June 4, 1984 indictment charges that Parsons raised at least \$462,166 from public investors through the offer and sale of fractional undivided working interests in oil and gas leases issued by Ok-La-Tex Production, Inc. The indictment further charged that Parsons misappropriated \$253,598.31 of investor funds to his own use and benefit. (U.S. v. Philip Harmon Parsons, WDLA, February 27, 1985, CR-84-50024-01). WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Western Massachussets Blectric Company, subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, to create a second class of preferred stock. (Rel. 35-23625 - March 8)

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 2 to request a hearing on a proposal by Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company, to increase the authorized number of common stock shares from 12,000,000 to 16,000,000. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. The proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-85-3) extends its pilot program relating to the implementation of a system for the execution, processing and reporting of standard odd-lot market orders to purchase or sell shares in American Telephone & Telegraph Co. (AT&T) and the equity shares created as a result of the AT&T divestiture from its scheduled expiration date of February 21, 1985 to February 21, 1986. (Rel. 34-21826)

AMENDMENT TO A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed an amendment to a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-83-22) to amend certain provisions of its proposed facilities management agreement procedures. (Rel. 34-21827)

CHESEBROUGH POND'S INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 2 to request a hearing on an application by Chesebrough Pond's Inc. for a finding by the Commission that Citibank N.A. should not be deemed to have a conflicting interest within the meaning of Section 310(b) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 which would disgualify it from acting as successor trustee under the following qualified indentures: (1) dated July 15, 1980 between Chesebrough and Morgan Guaranty Trust Company of New York relating to \$69,200,000 principal amount 10-5/8% notes, due July 15, 1990; and (2) dated June 1, 1984 between Chesebrough-Pond's Finance Corporation and Morgan Guaranty and Chesebrough, as guarantor, relating to an open-end indenture to issue debt securities as a result of acting as trustee under an indenture dated January 15, 1985 relating to \$100 million principal amount of 12% notes, due 1990. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
