U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NASD ACTION AGAINST HOWARD B. LABOW AFFIRMED

The Commission affirmed sanctions imposed by the NASD on Howard B. Labow, of Chicago. Labow was formerly a registered representative of The Equitable Life Assurance Society of the United States and its subsidiary, Equico Securities, Inc. The NASD censured Labow and fined him \$2,500.

Equitable's policy was to pay its salesmen annualized commissions on new life insurance. However, that policy did not apply when salesmen sold insurance on the lives of family members. The Commission affirmed the NASD's findings that Labow violated just and equitable principles of trade by falsifying an insurance application to conceal the fact that he was applying for insurance on the life of his wife, and subsequently refusing to return the commission he received although the policy that was issued was quickly cancelled under Equitable's "Money Back Guarantee - 10-day Free Look" program. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES D'ANGELO ENJOINED

The Boston Regional Office announced that on March 19 Judge M. Joseph Blumenfeld, U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut, entered, by consent, an Order of Permanent Injunction against Charles D'Angelo of Torrington, Connecticut. The Order permanently enjoins D'Angelo from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The complaint alleged that from December 1979 through July 1984, while employed as branch manager of the Waterbury, Connecticut office of Smith Barney, Harris Upham & Co., Inc., D'Angelo misappropriated approximately \$800,000 from the firm's clients. According to the complaint, D'Angelo perpetrated the fraud by causing unauthorized checks to be drawn on clients' accounts, forging the clients' signatures thereon and depositing most of the unauthorized, forged checks in bank accounts he controlled. Thereafter, D'Angelo used most of the misappropriated funds for personal options trading. (SEC v. Charles D'Angelo, USDC CT, 1985, Civil Action No. H85-237). (LR-10707)

FIRST OIL AND GAS COMPANY AND JOHN GUST WESTINE TEMPORARILY AND PRELIMINARILY ENJOINED

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on February 28 Judge Irving Hill, Central District of California, issued a Temporary Restraining Order and on March 11 an Order of Preliminary Injunction restraining and enjoining First Oil and Gas Company and John Gust Westine from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. These orders also placed a freeze on First Oil's and Westine's bank accounts.

The Pebruary 27 complaint alleges that: from at least March 1984 and continuing to the present, First Oil, Westine and others offered and sold interests in producing oil and gas wells or in oil and gas drilling sites on properties located in Coalinga, California in the form of limited partnership interests and investment contracts; California in the form of limited partnership interests and investment contracts; First Oil and Westine misrepresented the existence of drilling operations, the amount of money earned from drilling operations, the use of investors' funds, and the sources of funds used to pay returns to investors in the securities; First Oil violated the offunds used to pay returns to investors in the securities; First Oil violated the broker registration provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of limited broker registration provisions of the securities laws in the offer and westine partnership interests; and through these offers and sales, First Oil and Westine raised approximately \$2.5 million from at least 400 investors located nationwide.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved an amendment to Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board Rule G-3 (SR-MSRB-85-3) to require a person who otherwise is a municipal securities municipal, and who has been associated for two or more years with a municipal securities broker or municipal securities dealer that has not filed with the MSRB in compliance with Rule Rule A-12 to pass the Municipal Securities Principal Exam and be qualified as a municipal securities representative in order to retain his/her status as a municipal securities principal.
