RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

COMMENTS SOLICITED ON THE COSTS AND BENEFITS OF RULE 15c2-11

The Commission is soliciting public comments on the costs and benefits associated with Rule 15c2-11 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, which regulates the publication of quotations by broker-dealers for certain over-the-counter securities. The Commission has identified certain costs and benefits that appear to be associated with the Rule and has included a series of questions about these matters.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES VISION COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on April 1 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Vision Communications Corporation of Ridgefield, New Jersey. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief.

The Commission alleges that as part of a continuing course of conduct extending over several years, Vision, in disregard of its statutory obligations, failed to file or failed to file on time certain Annual and Quarterly Reports on Forms 10-K and 10-Q and certain Notifications of Late Filing on Form 12b-25. The Commission requests that the Court order Vision to file its delinquent Annual Report and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Vision Communications Corporation, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 85-1026). (LR-10715)

NORTHERN PACIFIC GAS AND OIL, LTD., OTHERS

The Los Angeles Regional Office filed a complaint on March 6 in the Central District of California against Northern Pacific Gas & Oil, Ltd., Ralph L. Muscatelli and Edward Mazur seeking a temporary restraining order, orders of preliminary and permanent injunction and other ancillary relief for violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Court denied the request for temporary relief but granted the Commission expedited discovery.

The complaint alleges that: the defendants raised approximately \$2.4 million through the sale of unregistered securities in the form of investment contracts; in connection with the sales, the defendants misrepresented that Northern Pacific had discovered oil on its leased properties, and that it would begin drilling for oil on ivnestors' lands within 120 days after their purchase; the defendants failed to disclose that approximately 45% of all funds received from investors were paid in commissions; and Northern Pacific had been the subject of a cease and desist order issued by the state of Iowa.

A hearing date has not been set on the Commission's request for a preliminary injunction. (SEC v. Northern Pacific Gas & Oil, Ltd., et al. CDCA, Civil Action No. 85-1538 TJH [JRX]). (LR-10716)

ORDER OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST DWAIN KNIGGE, UNDERTAKING AGAINST AMERICAN REGISTRAR AND TRANSFER CO.

The Denver Regional Office announced that on March 12 Judge Zita Weinshienk, U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado, entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Dwain Knigge of Salt Lake City, Utah, and an Order of Undertaking against American Registrar and Transfer Co., a registered transfer company owned and controlled by Knigge in Salt Lake City. The Order of Permanent Injunction permanently enjoined Knigge from violations of the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933. The Order of Undertaking ordered American not to engage in violations of the registration provisions of the Securities Act.

Knigge and American consented to the respective orders without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's June 3, 1983 Amended Complaint which alleged that American, acting as transfer agent, and Knigge, as American's owner and control person, aided and abetted the public distribution of the unregistered stock of an inactive shell company. (SEC v. Leslie D. Murdock, et al., USDC CO, 83-Z-777).

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

MICHAEL LEBLANC, OTHERS PLEAD GUILTY

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on March 27 Michael J. LeBlanc, Bernard E. LeBlanc and Rodney V. Kilbreath entered pleas of guilty to one count each of securities and mail fraud.

The indictment, returned on August 13, 1984 in Detroit, Michigan, alleged that the defendants: from about June 1977 to September 1982, through Remvest Securities, a Michigan broker-dealer, sold trust certificates, issued by Remvest Mutual Investment Trust, and mortgage-backed promissory notes, ussued by Remvest Federal, to approximately 800 investors, who invested about \$10.5 million in such securities; and in the sale of securities, misrepresented and omitted to state certain material facts concerning the safety and liquidity of such investments. The action is continued as to defendant Francis D. LeBlanc. (U.S. v. Francis LeBlanc, et al., CR 84-20450, USDC EDMI, S. Div.). (LR-10718)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BAKER, FENTRESS & COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 29 to request a hearing on an application of Baker, Fentress & Company requesting an order granting an exemption from Section 2(a)(3)(D) of the Investment Company Act in connection with its proposed purchases of less than five percent limited partnership interests in various limited partnerships. (Rel. IC-14447 - April 2)

BOETTCHER VENTURE CAPITAL PARTNERS, L.P.

An order has been issued exempting from the provisions of Section 57(a)(4) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1: (1) a joint portfolio investment program between Boettcher Venture Capital Partners, L.P., and Institutional Partners, L.P.; and (2) the referral of investment opportunities by Boettcher & Company, Inc. to certain limited partners of Institutional Partners, L.P. (Rel. IC-14448 - April 2)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

An order has been issued regarding Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries authorizing the system's short-term borrowing program through March 31, 1987. (Rel. 35-23650 - April 3)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, proposed rule changes filed by The American Stock Exchange, Inc. and The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. The proposals, SR-Amex-85-2 and SR-NASD-85-7, would establish a surcharge that Amex and NASD members may impose on issuers for forwarding proxy materials to beneficial owners of those issuers. (Rel. 34-21915)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

INTERMARK, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 27 to request a hearing on an application by Intermark, Inc. for a determination by the Commission that United States Trust Company of New York should not be deemed to have a conflicting interest within the meaning of Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939, which would disqualify it from acting as trustee under certain specified indentures. The indentures are: (1) dated April 1, 1985 governing Intermark's 13.20% senior subordinated debentures, Series B, due October 1, 1998; and (2) dated October 17, 1983 governing \$1,000 principal amount 13.20% senior subordinated debentures, due October 1, 1998.
