## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

#### PROCEEDINGS ORDERED AGAINST JOHN E. HARRINGTON AND GREGORY B. ARNOTT

The Commission issued an Order for Public Administrative Proceedings under Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice to determine whether John E. Harrington, formerly a partner in the Minneapolis, Minnesota office of Fox and Company, violated the securities laws and engaged in improper professional conduct in connection with Fox's audits of Flight Transportation Corporation's 1979, 1980 and 1981 financial statements, and whether Gregory B. Arnott, formerly a manager in Fox's Minneapolis office, engaged in improper professional conduct in connection with the same audits.

The Office of the Chief Accountant alleges, among other things, that Harrington falsely stated that Flight's financial statements fairly presented the financial position and results of operations of Flight in conformity with generally accepted accounting practices, when he knew, or was reckless in not knowing, that they did not; and that Arnott, among other things, failed to adhere to generally accepted accounting standards and failed to meet his professional responsibilities by failing to document properly his concerns or disagreements regarding the sufficiency of the audit evidence.
