

### **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

MAIN STREET SECURITIES, INC. AND MARK K. CHRISTIANSEN SANCTIONED

The Commission entered an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Main Street Securities, Inc., a registered Salt Lake City, Utah broker-dealer, and Mark K. Christiansen, a principal and the president of Main Street. The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement submitted jointly by Main Street and Christiansen.

In their Offer, without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Order for Proceedings, Main Street and Christiansen consented to an Order Making Findings that they wilfully violated: the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 when they unlawfully offered and sold stock of controlling persons without conducting a reasonable inquiry as to the source and trading status of the stock; and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 by charging customers excessive markups and unfair prices in a stock in which they dominated and controlled the market. The Order, among other things, suspends Christiansen from association with any broker-dealer for 20 days and censures and limits the business activities of Main Street for specified periods of time. #### **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

SUIT FILED AGAINST ZARCON CORPORATION AND CHARLES E. KIMBLE

The Commission filed, on May 2, a complaint for permanent injunction in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California against Zarcon Corporation, of Berkeley, California, and its president and founder, Charles E. Kimble of Vallejo, California. In its complaint, the Commission alleged that Zarcon and Kimble violated the antifraud and registration provisions of the securities laws. Kimble consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. The Case remains pending as to Zarcon.

The complaint alleged, among other things, that Zarcon and Kimble made false and misleading statements in an offering circular, two prospectuses and a registration statement filed with the Commission in late 1983, concerning, among other things, the underwriting of Zarcon's proposed initial public offering, and the research activities and financial condition of Zarcon. The Commission also alleges that Zarcon and Kimble falsely represented that the financial statements included in the registration statement were audited. (SEC v. Zarcon Corporation and Charles Kimble, Civil Action No. C85-3219 [TEH], NDCA, May 2, 1985). (LR-10741)

ENERGY FUND INCORPORATED

An order has been issued amending the terms of a previous Commission order permitting Energy Fund Incorporated, Guardian Mutual Fund, Inc. and The Partners Fund, Inc. to lend their portfolio securities to Neuberger & Berman (their subadviser and principal broker), subject to certain conditions. #### E. F. HUTTON & COMPANY, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by E. F. Hutton & Company, Inc. and The E. F. Hutton Group, Inc. for an order exempting them from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act respecting the circumstances described in the application. In addition, a temporary order has been issued granting the requested relief for 180 days from the date of the order, or such earlier time as the Commission may direct, unless extended by the Commission, pending a final determination by the Commission on the application. #### LIBRA BANK PLC

An order has been issued exempting Libra Bank PLC, a United Kingdom commercial bank, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14500 - May 2)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
