## CIML PROCEEDMGS

THE MIDNESTERN COMPANIES, INC. BNJOINED, OTHER RELIEF GRANTED
The Comission today announced that the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction permanentiy enjoining The Midwestern Companies, Inc. from violating certain provisions of the securities laws and ordering other relief. Midwestern consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The complaint alleged that Midwestern violated antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the periodic reporting, proxy soliciting and recordkeeping-internal controls provisions of the Exchange Act. According to the complaint, Midwestern, among other things, filed with the Comission materially false and misleading financial statements for the year ended December 31, 1982 and the first three quarters of 1983. The Comission alleged that Midwestern's reported revenues, net earnings, assets and shareholders' equity were materially overstated. Additionally, the Comission alleged that Midwestern submitted false documentation to its independent auditors. (SEC $V$. The Midwestern Companies, Inc.. USDC DC, Civil Action No. 85-1529). RELEASE DISCUSSING PROPOSED RULE CHANGES
The Comission issued a release discussing proposals by The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc, and six national securities exchanges relating to options on over-the-counter stocks and stock indexes. (Rel. 34-22026)

Companies and individuals must report to the Comaission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13 (d) (1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
