CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES H. GAMAREKIAN ADMITS TO VIOLATING FEDERAL SECURITIES LAWS

The New York Regional Office announced July 31 that the Honorable Shirley Wohl Kram, U.S. District Judge for the Southern District of New York, entered a Final Judgment Premanent Injunction and Order of Disgorgement By Consent Against Defendant Charles Haig Gamarekian ("Gamarekian"), in the matter of SEC v. Netelkos et al., 84 Civil 0335 (SWK).

Defendant Gamarekian admitted that, from April 1982 until September 1983, he and others at Falcon Sciences, Inc., a public company whose stock was traded on NASDAQ, issued and distributed over six million shares of unregistered, unauthorized and counterfeit Falcon stock through branch offices of numerous American brokerage firms located in Switzerland, England and the United States. Over \$3 million worth of the bogus Falcon stock was sold to the public through these brokerage firms. Public trading in Falcon stock on the over-the-counter market is currently suspended.

Gamarekian also consented to be permanently enjoined from violating the registration and anti-fraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the anti-fraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and from aiding and abetting violations by others of the public company reporting requirements and the transfer agent registration provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Gamarekian also agreed to disgorge \$100,000, representing illegally obtained proceeds from the violative scheme.
