COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FOURTH ANNUAL SEC GOVERNMENT-BUSINESS FORUM ON SMALL BUSINESS CAPITAL FORMATION

The Small Business Investment Incentive Act of 1980 directs the Commission to conduct an annual Government-Business Forum for the purpose of reviewing the financing problems of small businesses. This year, proposals before Congress to restructure the nation's tax system may significantly alter the financial course of the small business sector. Matters concerning federal and state securities regulation will be considered in addition to the tax issues. Forum recommendations are presented to Congress and to federal agencies which may have an interest in the issues discussed. Previous Forum recommendations have resulted in significant legislative and regulatory initiatives. The Forum will be held on September 12, 13, and 14 at Loew's L'Enfant Plaza in Washington, DC.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

KENNETH P. FELIS BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Kenneth P. Felis under Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously with the institution of these proceedings, Felis submitted an Offer of Settlement for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised by these proceedings.

In accepting Felis' Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Felis was found guilty on June 24 by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York of, among other things, 16 counts of securities fraud. The Commission also found Felis had been permanently enjoined on August 5 by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. These charges stemmed from a scheme entered into by Felis and four others to purchase securities while in possession of material non-public information misappropriated from the Wall Street Journal. Based upon these findings, the Commission ordered that Felis be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser or investment company. (Rel. 34-22289)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST KENNETH P. FELIS

The Commission announced that on August 5 the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief against Kenneth P. Felis. Felis consented to the order without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations. The final judgment enjoins and restrains Felis from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Securities Act of 1933. The final judgment also orders Felis to disgorge \$159,813.93, which Felis represented was his share of the gross profits from his account, and from the accounts of Western Hemisphere Trade Corp. #2 and Felis' business partner.

The complaint alleges that Felis, a former broker at Kidder Peabody & Co., engaged in a scheme with Peter N. Brant, R. Foster Winans, Jr., David W.C. Clark and David J. Carpenter to purchase securities while in possession of material non-public information misappropriated from the Wall Street Journal. As a result of the scheme, profits from the transactions cited in the complaint totaled \$918,627.63. (SEC v. Peter N. Brant, et al., 84 Civ. 3470, CBM, SDNY, Judgment entered August 5, 1985). INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE VOLUNTEER STATE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Volunteer State Life Insurance Company, Chubb/Volunteer Separate Account A, Chubb Investment Advisory Corporation, and Chubb Securities Corporation from Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(1), 26(a)(2)(C), 27(a)(1), 27(a)(2), 27(h)(1), 27(h)(2) and 27(h)(4) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 6e-3(T)(b)(1), (b)(13), (i)(B), (b)(13)(iii), (c)(1), (c)(2), (c)(4) and (c)(7) to permit them to offer certain flexible premium variable life insurance contracts. VARIABLE INVESTMENT PRODUCTS SERIES FUND, INC. ; SUN LIFE OF CANADA (U.S.) VARIABLE ACCOUNT D

Orders have been issued declaring that Variable Investment Products Series Fund, Inc. and Sun Life of Canada (U.S.) Variable Account D, previously registered as an open-end, diversified, management investment company and a unit investment trust, respectively, have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-14654; IC-14655 - Aug. 5)

TAX-FREE CASH RESERVE, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 26 to request a hearing on an application filed by Tax-Free Cash Reserve, Inc., Liquid Investments Co., Short-Term Investments Co., AIM Advisors, Inc., Alex. Brown Cash Reserve Fund, Inc. and Alex. Brown & Sons Incorporated (Alex. & Sons), on behalf of themselves and all future similar investment companies and portfolios thereof which may be sponsored, advised, administered or distributed by AIM or Alex. & Sons or their affiliates.
