ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

US SEGURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

SAMUEL W. SIGLER SUSPENDED AND TRADING ACTIVITIES LIMITED

The Commission entered Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) against Samuel W. Sigler, of Stamford, Connecticut, formerly associated with MV Securities, Inc. The Order, to which Sigler consents without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, ends the March 21, 1985 administrative proceeding instituted against him.

The proceeding charged that, from October 1982 to August 1983, Sigler made materially misleading statements and omitted to disclose material facts to at least 20 MVS customers respecting certain municipal securities issued by the Washington Public Power Supply System for WPPSS nuclear power plants, issued by the Michigan State Hospital Finance Authority for Martin Place Madison Heights Hospital, and issued by the City of Highland Park, Michigan Hospital Finance Authority for the Michigan Osteopathic Medical Center, Inc.

In its Order the Commission finds that Sigler violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Securities Act of 1933, and Rules G-17 (deceptive practices) and G-19 (suitability of transactions) of the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board, and suspends Sigler from associating with a broker dealer for six months, and subjects his trading activities following suspension of certain limitations, including prohibition against any contact with retail customers of a broker dealer, for an additional 12 months.
