COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

LOST AND STOLEN SECURITIES PROGRAM REFLECTS STRONG INCREASE IN UTILIZATION

> The dollar value of lost, missing or stolen securities located through the Commission's Lost and Stolen Securities Program increased by 31.4% during 1984, representing an aggregate dollar value increase from \$12,135,068 in 1983 to \$15,947,001 in 1984. The data base, operated and maintained by the Securities Information Center (SIC), currently contains information on certificates with a market value of approximately \$8 billion. The aggregate dollar value of certificates reported to SIC as lost, missing, stolen or counterfeit in 1984 was \$1,238,758,398, an 18.5 percent increase over 1983. SIC also received 2,658,886 inquiries during 1984, an increase of 17.5 percent over the number of inquiries received in 1983. (Press Release 85-50)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE RIGHTIME FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 11 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Rightime Fund, Inc. (Applicant), requesting an order exempting it from the provisions of Section 17(f) of the Investment Company Act. The exemption will permit Applicant's proposed transactions in financial futures contracts and its related practices in connection with margin deposits and in connection with variation margin owed to Applicant. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

An order has been issued authorizing New England Electric System, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to \$100 million of short-term notes to banks through March 31, 1987, an increase of \$60 million over the previously authorized amount. (Rel. 35-23832 - Sept. 18)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to acquire, by lease or purchase, up to an aggregate of 600 aluminum coal hopper railroad cars prior to December 31, 1986 for use in transporting coal by unit train to coal-fired generating plants owned and/or operated by Georgia. As amended, the disclosure document consolidates into a single revised document information formally found in four separate disclosure booklets, and includes new discussions of recent changes in the options markets.
