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# **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

#### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST DAVID D. CAREY

Public administrative proceedings have been instituted against David D. Carey, formerly a registered municipal securities representative with Bank of America's Bank Investment Securities Division in San Mateo, California.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that, in April 1985, a judgment of conviction was entered against Carey following a February 1985 jury trial in which he was found guilty of felonies involving theft, misappropriation and fraud relating to bearer bonds with a face value of \$455,000.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations are true and whether any remedial actions should be taken by the Commission. (Rel. 34-22428)

#### JACOB EDERMAN SANCTIONED

In administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Jacob Ederman, formerly associated as a registered representative with Philips, Appel and Walden, Inc., submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted. Ederman consented to an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) and admitted the findings contained therein.

The Order finds that Ederman was convicted of unlawfully, wilfully and knowingly, and contrary to his oath and affirmation, making false material declarations in a proceeding before a grand jury.

Respondent consented to an Order: (1) suspending him from association in any capacity with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer; (2) barring him from association in a supervisory or proprietary capacity with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer with the proviso that after two years he may make application to become so associated; and (3) requiring him, upon completion of his suspension, to submit a personal affidavit stating that he has complied with the Commission sanction and the affidavit of any prospective employer with whom he will seek to become associated demonstrating to the Commission's New York Regional Office that he will be adequately supervised. # **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

### COURT ORDER ENTERED AGAINST PETROLEUM SECURITIES FUND, OTHERS

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on September 23 Judge Horace W. Gilmore, U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan, Southern Division, entered an Order by consent requiring that Petroleum Securities Fund, 1982 Development Drilling Program, Limited Partnership #1 (PSF 1982-D1), Petroleum Securities Fund, 1981 Development Drilling Program, Limited Partnership #2 (PSF 1981-D2) and Michael Schouman, of Birmingham, Michigan, comply with undertakings not to violate Sections 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A), 13(b)(2)(B) and 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1, 13a-13, 15d-1 and 15d-13. PSF 1982-D1 also undertook not to violate the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act.

The complaint alleged that during 1982 and 1983, Schouman caused the management companies to borrow monies from and/or lend monies to PSF 1981-D2 and PSF 1982-D1 for other partnerships' use, record these transactions as accounts payable and accounts receivable to and from the management companies and, for part of 1983, overallocate and underallocate expenses to the partnerships. The complaint alleged accounting, filing and antifraud provisions. (SEC v. Petroleum Securities Fund, et al., EDMI, Civil Action No. 85-CV74323DT, filed September 23, 1985). (LR-10876)

#### SHERWOOD GRANT PETERSON, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on September 13 Judge Charles Norgle, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, entered a Final Judgment and Order of Permanent Injunction enjoining Sherwood Peterson, Financial Planning Services and Western Movies, Inc. from violating certain registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

While acting as an unregistered broker and investment adviser, Peterson sold various unregistered securities, including investment contracts in movies and fractional undivided working interests in oil wells. In connection with these sales, Peterson made misrepresentations and omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, the risk involved, rates of return, and the expertise and business connections of key people. (SEC v. Sherwood Grant Peterson, No. 83 C 2325, NDIL, September 13, 1985). (LR-10877)

## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

SAVINGS INDUSTRY PRIMARY LIQUIDITY FUND, INC.; SAVINGS INDUSTRY PRIMARY LIQUIDITY FUND II, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until October 25 to request a hearing on an application filed by Savings Industry Primary Liquidity Fund, Inc. and Savings Industry Primary Liquidity Fund II, Inc. for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-14739; IC-14740 - Sept. 30)

WORLD RESOURCES FUND, LTD.

An order has been issued declaring that World Resources Fund, Ltd. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14741 - Sept. 30)

#### FREEDOM INVESTMENT TRUST

An order has been issued granting Freedom Investment Trust exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35) and 22(c) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1 to permit the assessment of a contingent deferred sales charge on redemptions of shares. (Rel. IC-14742 - Sept. 30)

## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

### THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to 28,336,338 shares of its common stock under its Dividend Reinvestment and Stock Purchase Plan. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the issuance and sale by Southern of up to 3,903,431 shares its common stock under its Employee Savings Plan as to which the record is not yet complete. (Rel. 35-23846 - Sept. 30)

# **SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS**

## ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-85-14) that sets forth the rules and conditions applicable to the use of automatic execution systems placed on the PSE's floor to permit market makers to facilitate the entry of over-the-counter (OTC) stock orders for purposes of hedging or covering options positions on OTC stocks. (Rel. 34-22452)

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. and the American, New York, Pacific and Philadelphia Stock Exchanges (SR-CBOE-84-27, SR-NASD-85-15, SR-Amex-84-29, SR-NYSE-84-38, SR-PSE-84-20, SR-Phlx-84-32 and SR-Phlx-85-18) that establishes a uniform, premium-based customer margin system for short options positions. (Rel. 34-22469)

The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-CBOE-85-37) that sets forth certain fees and rebates to be offered in connection with the trading of foreign currency options. (Rel. 34-22470)
