COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN LEVITT ANNOUNCES TWO APPOINTMENTS IN THE DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT

Chairman Levitt today announced that he has appointed Colleen P. Mahoney, as Deputy Director of the Division of Enforcement. Ms. Mahoney has served as Executive Assistant to Chairman Levitt since his confirmation, in July 1993. She started her career at the Commission in 1983 in the Office of the General Counsel after practicing law at Steptoe & Johnson in Washington, D.C. In the Office of the General Counsel she served as a staff attorney, Special Counsel in the Counseling Section and as an Assistant General Counsel in the Litigation and Administrative Practices Section. In 1990, Ms. Mahoney was appointed Chief Counsel for the Division of Enforcement.

In addition, Chairman Levitt also announced the appointment of Jerry Isenberg as Principal Assistant Director of the Division of Enforcement. Mr. Isenberg, an honors graduate from the University of Texas and a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania Law School, was most recently the Assistant Director responsible for the Commission's action against Prudential Securities Inc. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM CORNETT PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on March 28 the Honorable David Bramlette, United States District Judge for the Southern District of Mississippi, entered a permanent injunction and other relief against defendant William D. Cornett (Cornett) of Port Lavaca, Texas prohibiting him from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The order also sets disgorgement as to Cornett at \$161,800 plus prejudgment interest, but waives payment, and declines to impose civil penalties, based on Cornett's inability to pay. Cornett consented to the relief without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint.

The Commission's complaint, filed March 10, 1993, alleges that Cornett and others, among other things, sold securities to investors by misrepresenting that Cornett had invented a device capable of locating gold and other precious minerals under the ground and that the device would be used to locate gold buried in the Philippines by the Japanese during World War II. JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST H. ELLIS RAGLAND, JR.

The Commission announced that on March 11 the Honorable J. Owen Forrester, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Georgia, permanently enjoined H. Ellis Ragland, Jr. (Ragland) of Atlanta, Georgia from future violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and ordered him to disgorge \$670,042, plus prejudgment interest, with payment waived based upon his demonstrated inability to pay. Ragland consented to the judgment without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint.

The Commission's complaint alleged that between June 1985 and September 1989, operating through Guaranty Financial Corporation of Georgia, Ragland raised over \$6 million from the sale of unregistered securities in the form of promissory notes and interests in real estate limited partnerships. Ragland commingled the funds of the various partnerships, paid supposed "profit distributions" to investors with proceeds invested by later investors, in the manner of a Ponzi scheme, and misappropriated a total of \$670,042 for his personal use. In addition, Ragland made material misrepresentations and omitted to disclose material facts to investors concerning the use of investor funds. [SEC v. H. Ellis Ragland. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BARCLAYS BANK PLC

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by Barclays Bank PLC under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(f) of the Act. The order permits registered management investment companies for which applicant acts as foreign custodian or subcustodian (other than investment companies registered under Section 7(d)) to maintain their foreign securities and other assets in the custody of certain foreign banks, each of which is a direct subsidiary of or associated with applicant. (Rel. IC-20192; International Series Rel. 647 - April 5)

CAPSTONE EQUITY SERIES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 2 to request a hearing on an application filed by Capstone Equity Series, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-20193 - April 5)

CAPSTONE CASHMAN FARRELL VALUE FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 2 to request a hearing on an application filed by Capstone Cashman Farrell Value Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-20194 - April 5)

WESTPAC BANKING CORPORATION

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Westpac Banking Corporation from Section 17(f) of the Act to permit the maintenance of foreign securities and other assets of registered investment companies, other than investment companies registered under Section 7(d), with Westpac Custodian Nominees Limited, an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of the Bank. CENTURY LIFE OF AMERICA, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Century Life of America, Century Variable Annuity Account (Account) and CUNA Brokerage Services, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The order provides exemptions to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Account under certain variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-20196 - April 6)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Participants Trust Company</u> (SR-PTC-93-05) relating to restrictions in the intraday payment of principal and interest. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of April 11. (Rel. 34-33856)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-94-04) to amend the AMEX's current policy to permit listed non-U.S. issuers to submit summary annual reports to shareholders and ADR holders. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of April 11. (Rel. 34-33864; International Series Release 646)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
