#### EMPORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ORDER MAKING FINDINGS AND IMPOSING REMEDIAL SANCTIONS AGAINST SHARON VAN DEN BERG BAKER, INDIVIDUALLY, AND DOING BUSINESS AS "SHARON V. BAKER SEC REGISTERED INVESTMENT ADVISOR" AND "SHARON V. BAKER SPECIAL ACCOUNT"

The Commission entered an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) in connection with previously instituted administrative proceedings against Sharon V. Baker (Baker), a South Florida-based investment adviser registered with the Commission.

The Commission accepted Baker's Offer of Settlement (Offer) whereby Baker consented to the entry of an Order barring her from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer investment adviser or investment company. Baker, without admitting or denying, consented to the Order's findings that from at least August 1991 through December 1992, Baker misrepresented to clients that she was investing their money in low-risk, high-interest, tax-free money market funds and notes when, in fact, she was using the monies for, among other things, personal expenses. Baker also failed to disclose that in December 1990, the New York Stock Exchange barred her from association with any member organization.

On June 19, 1993, the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida entered a judgment of permanent injunction, by consent, against Baker, based upon willful violations of the antifraud provisions of the Advisers Act, the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and of the recordkeeping and disclosure provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. ## FORMER CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF ARKANSAS BOND DEALER BARRED

The Commission has issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions in settlement of the administrative proceeding against Louis Jules Pagillo (Pagillo), formerly Chief Financial Officer of Swink & Co., Inc. (Swink & Co.), a now-defunct broker-dealer. Pagillo, without admitting or denying any of the matters set forth in the Order, consented to a bar from association with any broker, dealer, investment

adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. The Order found that Pagillo willfully aided and abetted Swink & Co. 's violations of the Commission's net capital rule, applicable books and records maintenance requirements and notification provisions. (Rel. 34-34048)

FAIRPORT ASSET MANAGEMENT CORP. AND ROGER GOETZ CONSENT TO CENSURE, SUSPENSION, PAYMENT OF \$25,000 PENALTY, ISSUANCE OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER, AND AGREE TO ADOPT REMEDIAL UNDERTAKINGS

The Commission today announced that Fairport Asset Management Corp. (FAMC), a Westport, Connecticut registered investment adviser, and Roger W. Goetz (Goetz) of Westport, Connecticut and the President and sole shareholder of FAMC, consented, without admitting or denying the matters set forth in the order, to the entry of an order pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Sections 203(e), 203(f) and 203(k) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, finding that FAMC and Goetz violated and aided and abetted violations of Sections 204, 206(1), 206(2), 206(4) and 207 of the Advisers Act and Rules 204-1, 206(4)-1(a)(5) and 206(4)-2. In addition, FAMC and Goetz were directed to cease and desist from committing or causing violations of these provisions. The order censures FAMC, suspends Goetz from association from any broker, dealer, investment adviser or investment company for a period of 90 days, orders Goetz to pay a \$25,000 penalty and orders FAMC and Goetz to comply with certain remedial undertakings. In the order, the Commission found that FAMC and Goetz defrauded FAMC's clients by employing a bank signature guarantee stamp that he had purchased without the knowledge or consent of the bank or FAMC's clients to effect 788 client mutual fund redemptions, totalling \$221,317.85, that FAMC's clients had previously authorized, and that FAMC and Goetz failed to comply with the Commission's advertising, recordkeeping and reporting rules. #### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

## EMERGING MARKETS GROWTH FUND, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by the Emerging Markets Growth Fund, Inc., et al. under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a), and under Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder permitting certain transactions. The order permits the Emerging Markets Growth Fund, Inc. to invest a small portion of its assets in an affiliated closed-end Luxembourg investment company that invests in equity securities of developing countries in Eastern Europe and the former Soviet republics. ## THE 231 FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by The 231 Funds (Fund) and Continental Bank N.A. (Adviser) for an order permitting certain joint transactions under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder. The requested order would permit the Fund's portfolios and certain other registered investment companies, and the investment advisers of such companies, jointly to enter into master repurchase agreements with non-affiliated financial institutions. # BANNER LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by Banner Life Insurance Company, Banner Life Variable Annuity Account B (Account B) and Banner Financial Services Group, Inc. (collectively, Applicants). The Applicants seek an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The order would provide exemptions to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of Account B in connection with the issuance and sale of certain flexible premium variable annuity contracts. ## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

## ENERGY INITIATIVES, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on a proposal by Energy Initiatives, Inc. (EII), General Portfolios Corporation (GPC), both non-utility subsidiaries of General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), and GPU, a registered holding company. EII, GPC and GPU propose that EII acquire through December 31, 1995 all of the stock of North Canadian Power Inc., a company involved with qualifying cogeneration facilities (QFs), for a total of \$72 million (Purchase Price) and enter into assumption agreements obligating EII to make payments up to \$25 million. Applicants also propose that GPU make up to \$72 million in capital contributions or loans to EII through December 31, 1995 to pay the Purchase Price and assume certain guarantees associated with the QFs and/or unconditionally guaranty EII's obligations and to make additional capital contributions up to a maximum aggregate amount of \$25 million. Finally, applicants propose that EII issue, sell and renew through December 31, 2004 notes in the aggregate principal amount of \$25 million, and for GPU to unconditionally guaranty the notes and EII's other related obligations. Jurisdiction is reserved over EII's proposals to issue and sell \$2.5 million of unsecured promissory notes

to banks and accept guarantees or supporting agreements from GPU and provide services to the QF projects as managing general partner under an exception to Section 13 under the Act. (Rel. 35-26053)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-88-35) filed by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> related to reviewing requests for extensions of time for payment or delivery of securities. (Rel. 34-34073)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-BSE-93-17) filed by the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> to adopt Chinese Wall procedures. (Rel. 34-34076)

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> to add an interpretation to the BEACON Liability Rule (SR-BSE-94-03) has become effective upon filing with the Commission.
