ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

INITIAL DECISION BARS JUAN CARLOS SCHIDLOWSKI FROM ASSOCIATING WITH A BROKER OR DEALER AND FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY OFFERING OF A PENNY STOCK

Administrative Law Judge Edward J. Kuhlmann has issued an initial decision barring Juan Carlos Schidlowski from association with a broker or dealer and from participating in any offering of a penny stock. The basis for the decision was the previously filed "Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction by Default with Respect to Juan Carlos Schidlowski," on August 7, 1987 and a plea agreement where Schidlowski

pleaded guilty to having conspired to defraud the United States. Both the civil and criminal cases were heard and decided by the United States District Court for the District of Colorado and arose out violations of Sections 5(a), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and 10(b), 15(a), 15(c)(3), and 17(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Schidlowski is currently serving a five-year term in federal prison in Colorado. The prison term resulted from the plea agreement and his fleeing the country after sentencing. CENCOM SYSTEMS, INC. AND JAY DEUTCHMAN CHARGED WITH RUNNING \$3.5 MILLION PONZI SCHEME

The Commission announced today the filing of a civil action against Cencom Systems, Inc. (Cencom) and Jay Deutchman (Deutchman) seeking a permanent injunction, disgorgement of proceeds from the illegal sale of securities and all other ill-gotten gains, prejudgment interest, and civil penalties. The complaint charges the defendants with violations of Sections 5 and 17 of the Securities Act of 1933, and Sections 10(b) and 15(a)(l) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

The Commission's complaint alleges that beginning in at least 1986 and continuing through at least 1993, Deutchman and Cencom, Deutchman's alter ego, offered and sold more than \$3.5 million in nonexempt, unregistered securities to more than twenty victims in a classic Ponzi scheme. The scheme was facilitated by Deutchman's misrepresentations and omissions of material facts. The complaint alleges, among other things, that by promising high rates of return, Deutchman induced victims to invest their money in "Muni Unit Trusts," which purported to be interests in pools of municipal bonds bought and sold by Deutchman. In fact, Deutchman did not invest in municipal bonds for the victims' benefit. Instead, Deutchman misappropriated his victims' money for his personal use and to perpetuate his scheme by lulling the victims with periodic interest payments.

Deutchman has apparently absconded with the victims' funds. [SEC v. v. Cencom Systems, Inc. and Jay Deutchman, 94 Civ. 4098, CSH, SDNY] (LR-14110)

FINAL JUDGMENTS ENTERED IN SETTLEMENT OF DISGORGEMENT AMOUNTS

The Commission announced that in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, agreed Final Judgments were entered as to defendants Maxwell C. Huffman (Huffman) and John J. Forsberg (Forsberg) on May 17, 1994. Huffman was ordered to turn over to the court-appointed Receiver in this action, personal property valued at \$10,000 and Forsberg was ordered to pay the sum of \$5,000. Based on the defendants' demonstrated financial inability to pay, the Commission agreed to waive the remaining disgorgement amounts of \$123.774.66 for Huffman, and \$147,719 for Forsberg.

On May 24, the District Court adopted the findings and recommendations of a Magistrate judge and entered a Final Judgement in favor of the Commission against defendants James T. Henry (Henry) and James F. Stewart (Stewart). Henry was ordered to disgorge \$201,943 and Stewart was directed to disgorge \$513,784. [SEC v. Maxwell C. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JOHN HANCOCK MUTUAL VARIABLE LIFE INSURANCE ACCOUNT UV, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting John Hancock Mutual Variable Life Insurance Account UV (Variable Account UV), John Hancock Variable Life Account V (Variable Account V), John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance Company, and John Hancock Variable Life Insurance Company exemptions from the following: provisions of the Act and those rules specified in paragraph (b) of Rule 6e-2 thereunder, other than Sections 7 and 8(a); Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 26(a)(1), 26(a)(2), 27(a)(1), 27(a)(3), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), 27(d) and 27(f) of the Act; and Rules 6e-2(b)(1), (b)(12), (b) (13) (i), (b) (13) (ii), (b) (13) (iii), (b) (13) (iv), (b) (13) (b) (13) (viii), (c) (1) and (c) (4), 22c-1, and 27f-1 thereunder. (b) (13) (v), order was sought in connection with the offer and sale of certain multioption variable life insurance policies (individually, the "Policy," collectively, Policies) that provide for the following: a death benefit which will not always vary based on investment performance; both a contingent deferred sales charge and a sales charge deducted from premiums, neither of which is subject to refunds; deduction of an administrative surrender charge on lapse or surrender; deduction from the Policy's account value of cost of insurance charges, charges for substandard mortality risks and incidental insurance benefits, and minimum death benefit guarantee risk charges; values and charges based 1980 Commissioners' Standard Ordinary Mortality Tables; elimination of, or reduction in, front-end sales charges in certain cases; the holding of mutual fund shares funding either Variable Account UV or Variable Account V in an open account arrangement, without a trust indenture and the use of a trustee; and a "free look" right which may provide for the return of amounts other than total premiums paid upon cancellation of a Policy. ABS EMPLOYEES' VENTURE FUND LIMITED PARTNERSHIP AND ALEX. BROWN INVESTMENTS INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by ABS Employees' Venture Fund

Limited Partnership and Alex. Brown Investments Incorporated for an order under Section 6(b) of the Investment Company Act granting relief from all of the provisions of the Act except Sections 9, 17 (except for certain provisions of Sections 17(a), (d), (f), (g), and (j) as described in the application), 30 (except for certain provisions of Section 30(a), (b), (d), and (f) as described in the application), and 36-53, and the rules and regulations thereunder. The Partnership will be an employees' securities company within the meaning of Section 2(a) (13) of the Act. (Rel. IC-20333 - June 2)

THE TRAVELERS INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting The Travelers Insurance Company and The Travelers Fund BD for Variable Annuities (Fund BD) from the provisions of Sections 26(a) (2) (C) and 27(c) (2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction from the assets of Fund BD of a mortality and expense risk charge imposed under certain individual flexible premium variable annuity contracts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INDIANA MICHIGAN POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by Indiana Michigan Power Company, an electric utility subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, to effect the refunding of up to \$50 million of pollution control revenue bonds issued in connection with the financing of pollution control facilities. (Rel. 35-26060)

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned electric utility subsidiary company, Central Power and Light Co. (CP&L) for CSW to establish a new limited-purpose communications subsidiary company -- CSW Communications; CSW to provide capital contributions and loans to CSW Communications and to guarantee its obligations in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$25 million; CSW Communications to issue \$1000 of its common stock to CSW; CSW Communications to acquire fiber optic assets from CP&L and to lease fiber optic capacity to CP&L; and CSW Communications to lease excess fiber optic capacity to unaffiliated third parties. (Rel. 35-26061)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
