SEC NAMES HEAD OF SAN FRANCISCO DISTRICT OFFICE

Chairman Arthur Levitt today announced that he has appointed David B. Bayless as the District Administrator of the SEC's San Francisco District Office. The San Francisco Office is part of the Commission's Pacific Region which has its headquarters office in Los Angeles. In his capacity as District Administrator, Mr. Bayless will manage the enforcement, examination and bankruptcy programs within the San Francisco Office's jurisdiction.

Mr. Bayless is currently a litigation partner in the Chicago office of McDermott, Will & Emery where he is responsible for coordinating and conducting trials with an emphasis on commercial litigation. He became associated with that firm in 1987 and was named partner in 1989. Mr. Bayless presently serves in the securities litigation practice group at the firm. From 1984 to 1987, Mr. Bayless was an associate with the law firm of Kirkland & Ellis in Chicago. Prior to that time, he was an associate with D'Ancona & Pflaum, a law firm in Chicago, and clerked for the Honorable Luther M. Swygert of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WILLIAMSBURG INVESTMENT TRUST, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Sections 6(c) and 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to permit applicant investment companies to deposit their daily uninvested cash balances into a single joint account to be used to enter into repurchase agreements. (Rel. IC-20376 - June 28)

PRINCOR BLUE CHIP FUND, INC., ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Princor Blue Chip Fund, Inc., et al. from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order permits applicants to issue multiple classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities, assess a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on certain redemptions of shares, and waive the CDSC in certain instances. (Rel. IC-20377 - June 28)

LEHMAN BROTHERS INSTITUTIONAL FUNDS GROUP TRUST, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by Lehman Brothers Institutional Funds Group Trust, et al. under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Sections 17(a) and 17(e)(1). The order permits the applicant investment companies to engage in certain transactions in U.S. government securities, repurchase agreements, tax-exempt obligations and taxable obligations with banks (and their affiliated persons) that are remote affiliates of the investment companies. ABS EMPLOYEES' VENTURE FUND LIMITED PARTNERSHIP AND ALEX. BROWN INVESTMENTS INCORPORATED

An order has been issued on an application filed by ABS Employees' Venture Fund Limited Partnership and Alex Brown Investments Incorporated under Sections 6(b) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act granting relief from all of the provisions of the Act except Sections 9, 17 (except for certain provisions of Sections 17(a), (d), (f), (g), and (j) as described in the application), 30 (except for certain provisions of Sections 30(a), (b), (d), and (f) as described in the application), and 36-53, and the rules and regulations thereunder. The Partnership will be an employees' securities company within the meaning of Section 2(a) (13). (Rel. IC-20379 - June 28)

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 19 to comment on the application of the <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> for unlisted trading privileges in 8 issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>Boston Stock</u> <u>Exchange</u> to strike from listing and registration DeWolfe Companies, Inc., Common Stock, \$.01 Par Value. (Rel. 34-34273)

THMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-94-11) that became effective upon filing to amend NSCC's fee for the Fund/Serv Service. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the June 27. (Rel. 34-34257)

The <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-94-14) that became effective upon filing to add a \$200.00 surcharge on broker-dealers that are made a party to an arbitration proceeding. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 4. (Rel. 34-34271)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-94-16) that would enhance the Exchange's audit trail account capabilities by adopting identification codes to indicate transactions that are exempt from the short sale rules. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 4. (Rel. 34-34269)

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-94-02) to impose fees on market makers who fail to observe certain participation duties on the Retail Automated Execution System (RAES) for equity and Standard & Poor's 500 Index (SPX) classes of options. Specifically, the CBOE proposes to amend CBOE Rules 8.16, "RAES Eligibility in Equity Options" and 24.16, "RAES Eligibility in SPX/NDX,"

to impose the following fees for failures to satisfy the rules' logoff requirements: a fee of \$100.00 for one to three failures within one
twelve-month period; a fee of \$250.00 for four to six failures within
one twelve-month period; and a fee of \$500.00 for seven or more failures
within one twelve-month period. In addition, the CBOE proposes to issue
a Regulatory Circular clarifying market makers' RAES responsibilities
with respect to equity and SPX options classes. Publication of the
notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 4.
