#### **ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS**

#### ROBERT STORMES BARRED

The Commission announced the entry of an Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Robert L. Stormes, a registered representative since 1982. The findings and sanctions are in accordance with an Offer of Settlement submitted by Stormes whereby he consented to the Order.

Pursuant to the Order and Offer, the Commission found that on September 15, 1993, Stormes was convicted by a plea of guilty of two counts of violating the antifraud provisions by misappropriating and converting his clients' assets of at least \$480,985 received by him in his capacity as a registered representative. The Commission also found that on June 30, 1994, Stormes was permanently enjoined from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5 of the Securities Act of 1934. The court noted the appropriateness of civil penalties in this instance but declined to order payment based on Stormes' demonstrated inability to pay.

The order further barred Stormes from association in any capacity with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-34350)

# CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ENTERED AGAINST KINESIS INC.

The Commission announced that on July 14 administrative proceedings pursuant to the Securities Act and the Exchange Act were instituted against Kinesis, Inc. for violations of Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. Simultaneously with the institution of these proceedings, the Commission

accepted Kinesis's Offer of Settlement in which the company consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to the entry of a cease and desist order against further violations of these statutory provisions.

Among other things, the Commission found that Kinesis' former Chairman of the Board of Directors disseminated false and misleading information to a boiler room that incorporated the information into its investment newsletter. The false and misleading information related to Kinesis' dealings with a leading athletic shoe manufacturer and the false claim that the Board of Directors had approved a reverse 8-1 stock split. Kinesis also issued and sold shares of stock in excess of the number authorized by the company's articles of incorporation. Finally, between September 1987 and April 1988, Kinesis violated Section 5 of the Securities Act by distributing approximately 114,000 unregistered shares of its stock to 113 investors. # CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ENTERED AGAINST BERNARD SHERMAN AND SHERMFIN CORP.

The Commission announced the institution of administrative proceedings pursuant to the Exchange Act on July 14 against Bernard Sherman for violating Sections 10(b), 13(g) and 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5, 13d-1 and 16a-1 thereunder; and Shermfin Corp. for violating Sections 13(g) and 16(a) and Rules 13d-1 and 16a-1 thereunder. Simultaneously with the institution of these proceedings, the Commission accepted Sherman's and Shermfin's Offers of Settlement in which they consented, without admitting or denying the findings, to the entry of a cease and desist order against further violations of these statutory provisions.

The Commission found that as of June 1, 1990, Sherman and Shermfin had acquired beneficial ownership of 57.3% of the outstanding common stock of Kinesis, Inc. As of June 1, 1990, Kinesis' stock was registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(q) of the Exchange Act. Commission found that Sherman and Shermfin did not file Schedules 13G until June 1993, thereby violating Section 13(g) of the Exchange Act and Rule 13d-1(c). The Commission also found that Sherman and Shermfin did not file Forms 3 until January 1994, thereby violating Section 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rule 16a-1. Finally, the Commission found that Sherman's willful failure to file a Schedule 13G relating to his acquisition of 41% of Kinesis' then outstanding stock, was materially misleading to the investing public, with respect to the true ownership of that stock and the size of his overall position in Kinesis, and constituted a violation of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

# MINNESOTA MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 12 to request a hearing on an application filed by Minnesota Mutual Life Insurance Company, Minnesota Mutual Group Variable Annuity Account (Separate Account) and MIMLIC Sales Corporation for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The order would provide exemptions to the extent necessary to permit the deduction from the assets of the Separate Account of a mortality and expense risk charge under certain variable annuity contracts. # FINANCIAL HORIZONS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 12 to request a hearing on an application filed by Financial Horizons Life Insurance Company, Financial Horizons VA Separate Account-3 (Account) and Nationwide Financial Services, Inc. for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The order would provide exemptions to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Account under certain variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-20409 - July 18)

#### SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

#### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-94-03) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange which allows the PHLX to list and trade long-term reduced-value options on the National Over-the-Counter Index (reduced-value XOC) equal to one-tenth of the value of the current full-value XOC (XOC). Options on the reduced-value XOC will trade in addition to options on the full-value XOC. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 18. (Rel. 34-34387)

## PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-94-01) to permit approval by the Exchange of member organizations in other than partnership or corporate form. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 18. (Rel. 34-34390)
