EXCHANGE COMMISSION

WILLIAM L. BLAIR SANCTIONED

The Commission entered Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions in an administrative proceeding against William L. Blair of Knoxville, Tennessee. Blair is a registered representative with the Knoxville branch office of a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. The Commission's Order was entered under an Offer of Settlement submitted by Blair, wherein he admitted being permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee from future violations of the antifraud and margin provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Blair neither admitted nor denied other allegations contained in the Order for Proceedings and consented to findings of violations and sanctions imposed.

Upon consideration of the Order for Proceedings and the Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Blair wilfully violated the above-mentioned provisions of the Exchange Act and Regulation X of the Federal Reserve Board, through a course of trading in securities while employed as a registered representative.

Based on the findings and Offer of Settlement, Blair was suspended from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer or investment adviser for four months, and barred from association with such entities in a supervisory or proprietary capacity, with the provision, however, that after 15 months, he may apply to become associated in a supervisory or proprietary capacity.
