CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PORTLAND, OREGON BROKER-DEALER ENJOINED AND TRUSTEE APPOINTED

> The Seattle Regional Office announced that on June 7 a complaint was filed and a decree of permanent injunction was entered by consent in U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon against June S. Jones Co., a Portland, Oregon broker-dealer, and June Sheldon Jones, Jr., its president, for violations of the Commission's financial responsibility rules. SIPC applied for and received an order appointing a trustee to liquidate the firm. (SEC v. June S. Jones Co., et al., No. 84-619, D. OR). (LR-10416)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

FORMER SIPA TRUSTEE PLEADS GUILTY

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on June 12 David Robb entered a plea of guilty to a one-count criminal Information that had been filed on June 5 in the Federal Court at Detroit, Michigan. The Information charged that Robb had violated Sections 14(c)(1) and (2) of the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970 (SIPA).

The Information charged that Robb, an attorney: on September 18, 1974 was appointed and served as Trustee under the SIPA for the liquidation of Financial House, Inc., a Detroit brokerage firm which was insolvent, until his resignation on March 29, 1983; from about June 1977 to March 29, 1983, embezzled and converted to his own use and benefit approximately \$196,249 belonging to the estate of Financial House and the Securities Investor Protection Corporation, resulting in additional loss to the estate of about \$104,605 of interest; drew checks on an account at a Detroit bank in his name as Trustee and converted the proceeds to his own use; failed to deposit all monies received by him as Trustee, including proceeds from the sales of securities, dividends on securities, and a state tax refund; converted proceeds from two certificates of deposit held by the estate; prepared or caused to be prepared two false documents which purported to be certificates of deposit issued by a Detroit bank; and prepared and filed false reports with the U.S. District Court and the U.S. Bankruptcy Court at Detroit.
