
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

AMEX ACTION AGAINST SMITH BARNEY AFFIRMED

The Commission affirmed the American Stock Exchange's censure of Smith Barney, Harris Upham & Co. Incorporated for conduct inconsistent with just and equitable principles of trade.

The Commission found, as had the Exchange, that in April 1978 Smith Barney effected certain transactions in the options of Aetna Life and Casualty Company for its own account before a firm research recommendation respecting Aetna stock was disseminated to the firm's public customers. The Commission stated: "In order to avoid any potential conflict of interest, a firm should give its customers sufficient time to receive and digest a research recommendation that represents a material change in the firm's position before the firm trades the subject stock or related options for its own account." NASD ACTION AGAINST C. JAMES PADGETT AFFIRMED

The Commission affirmed sanctions imposed by the NASD on C. James Padgett of Denver, former executive vice president of Universal Heritage Investments Corporation. The NASD censured Padgett, fined him \$5,000, and suspended him from serving as a principal with any member firm for six months, with the added requirement that he re-qualify as a principal by examination.

The NASD imposed the above sanctions under the Commission's remand of the proceedings for reassessment of sanctions following Padgett's initial appeal. On that appeal, the Commission set aside NASD findings that Padgett had participated in manipulation and fraud that occurred at one of Universal's branch offices, but found that Padgett was responsible for a serious lapse in his supervisory responsibilities respecting that misconduct.

In affirming the NASD's assessment of sanctions on remand, the Commission noted that Padgett's lapse had permitted the continuation of very serious violations at Universal's branch office, that in another proceeding the Commission had affirmed NASD findings that Padgett was responsible for deficient supervision at his present firm, and that the NASD, in substantially reducing the sanctions it had previously imposed, gave ample recognition to the fact that several findings against Padgett had been set aside. An order has been granting PB-SB 1984 Investment Partnership V and PB-SB 1984 Investment Partnership V-A, limited partnerships organized for employees of Salomon Brothers Inc. and Phibro Salomon Inc., and PB-SB Ventures Inc., their general partner: an exemption, with certain exceptions, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act; an exemption from Sections 6(b) and 2(a)(13) of the Act; and confidential treatment under Section 45(a) of the Act.
