ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NASD ACTION AGAINST MICHAEL E. FLICK AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed sanctions imposed by the NASD on Michael E. Flick, a Tulsa, Oklahoma securities salesman. The NASD censured Flick and suspended him from association with any NASD member for 60 days or until such time as he regualifies as a registered representative by examination, whichever period is longer.

The sanctions were based on findings that, in 1981, Flick failed to notify his then employer of his solicitation of and sale to customers of interests in a limited partnership, Hale and Associates Drilling-1981 (Associates), and misused the funds of a customer who sought to invest in Associates. Contrary to representations made in the Associates' offering circular, the customer's funds were not deposited in a national bank, were not promptly returned to the customer with interest when Associates did not raise \$400,000 by the date specified, and were used to purchase a list of potential investors.

In determining that the sanctions imposed by the NASD were not excessive, the Commission noted that Flick had engaged in serious misconduct. It also took into account the fact that Flick deliberately deceived NASD investigators who were probing his role in the Associates offering. (Rel. 34-21404)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

ALFRED GELLMAN ORDERED TO DISGORGE MONEY TO COLORADO DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION RECEIVER

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on October 17 Judge Sidney M. Aronovitz, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida, issued a Final Judgment of Disgorgement against Alfred I. Gellman of Miami Beach, Florida. The Final Judgment requires Gellman to disgorge \$977,311 to Marsha L. Lyons, Esquire, of Coral Gables, Florida, the court-appointed Receiver for Colorado Development Corporation. On September 22, 1983, Gellman consented, without admitting or denying, to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction. On October 15, 1984, the Court held an evidentiary hearing and found that the defendants received \$1,090,600 from investors in the Glasgow Lode Mineral Aggregate Program. The complaint alleged that the defendants fraudulently sold unregistered securities in the form of investment contracts involving the sale of piles of mineral aggregate coupled with an aggrement to process the aggregate into gold and silver. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BAYSWATER REALTY & CAPITAL CORP.

SHEARSON LEHMAN/COAST HOUSING PARTNERS, LIMITED

An order has been issued on an application filed by Shearson Lehman/Coast Savings Housing Partners, Limited (Partnership), a California limited partnership, and its general partners, Shearson Housing Programs Corporation II, National Partnership Investments Corp., and Coast Housing Investment Associates, exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. CASH ACCUMULATION TRUST

An order has been issued exempting Cash Accumulation Trust from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Investment Company Act to permit acquisition of puts from brokers and dealers. (Rel. IC-14218 - Oct. 30)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-84-23) which amends the NASD's proposed Code of Procedure (SR-NASD-82-11) by creating a Market Surveillance Committee and specifying that committee's operating procedures. The proposal also deletes Section 8 of the Code, which deals with the violation of rules of the National Association of Securities Dealers Automated Quotation System, since the proposal transfers jurisdiction over those proceedings to the Market Surveillance Committee. TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

UNION PACIFIC CORPORATION

A corrected notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 19 to request a hearing on an application by the Union Pacific Corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939, declaring that the trusteeship of Citibank, N.A. under certain specified indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disgualify Citibank from acting as trustee.
