### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

INITIAL DECISION DENIES PHILIP WILSON INVESTMENT ADVISER REGISTRATION, BARS WILSON

> Administrative Law Judge Max O. Regensteiner issued an initial decision denying an application for investment adviser registration by Philip S. Wilson and barring him from association with an investment adviser. According to the decision, Wilson's application form failed to disclose disciplinary actions taken against him by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (CBOE) in 1979 and 1983 and misrepresented another CBOE action that was affirmed by the Commission in 1986. In that action, Wilson was barred from CBOE membership and from association with any member. On appeal, the Com-mission had affirmed CBOE findings that Wilson misappropriated a substantial amount of money from a partnership of which he was managing general partner.

> The initial decision is subject to Commission review on petition of a party or on the Commission's own initiative.

#### **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

JOHN MUSELLA SETTLES INSIDER TRADING CHARGE

The Commission announced that on December 14, 1988 U.S. District Judge Kimba Wood, Southern District of New York, entered a permanent injunction against John Musella, enjoining him from further violations of the antifraud and tender offer provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3.

The Commission had alleged that Musella effected transactions in the common stock, or in option contracts to purchase the common stock, of a publicly-held company, Marathon Oil Company, while in possession of material, non-public information relating to the proposed acquisition of that company or its securities. The Commission had alleged that Musella improperly obtained the material, non-public information, directly or indirectly, from Alan Robert Ihne, who was manager of office services at Sullivan & Cromwell.

Musella consented to the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. The case is proceeding against the remaining defendant. (SEC v. Dominick Musella, et al., USDC SDNY, Civil Action No. 83-0342). (LR-11957)

#### **CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS**

ROBERT A. DIIANNI INDICTED

The Boston Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Massachusetts announced that on December 21, 1988 Robert A. Dilanni of Boston, Massachusetts was indicted on 45 counts of securities fraud, mail fraud, wire fraud, and the interstate transportation of stolen property. The indictment alleges that Dilanni, a former investment adviser and principal of a broker-dealer who was barred from the securities business by the Commission in 1984, engaged in four separate schemes to defraud, including inducing a large number of investors in the United States and overseas to provide him monies to invest or manage on their behalf, which monies Dilanni then converted for his personal benefit, and inducing brokerage firms to purchase substantial amounts of securities for which he did not intend to pay.

The indictment follows a civil injunctive action by the Commission in which Dilanni was enjoined from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The investigation leading to this action was a result of a referral by District 13 of the NASD. (U.S. v. Robert A. Dilanni, USDC DMA, Criminal No. 88-371-WD). (LR-11958)

**PIRST INVESTORS KILDOYLE FUND, INC.; PRINCIPAL EQUITY FUND ACCUMULATION PLAN; PRINCIPAL EQUITY FUND, INC.** 

An order has been issued declaring that First Investors Kildoyle Fund, Inc.; Principal Equity Fund Accumulation Plan; and Principal Equity Fund, Inc. have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-16730; IC-16731; IC-16732 - Dec. 30, 1988)

MACKAY-SHIELDS MAINSTAY SERIES FUND

An order has been issued on an application filed by MacKay-Shields MainStay Series Fund to permit it to file financial statements signed or certified by an independent public accountant selected at a Board of Trustees meeting held more than 30 but not mor than 90 days before or after the beginning of its fiscal year. STRUCTURED ASSET FUNDING CORPORATION

MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, MSU System Services, Inc., Arkansas Power & Light Company, Louisiana Power & Light Company, Mississippi Power & Light Company, New Orleans Public Service Inc., System Fuels, Inc., and System Energy Resources, Inc., to continue a system money pool and to sell short-term notes to banks and commercial paper dealers from time to time through December 31, 1990. NEW ENGLAND HYDRO-TRANSMISSION CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing New England Hydro-Transmission Corporation (NEH-NH) and New England Hydro-Transmission Electric Company (NEH-M), a registered holding company, to acquire the common stock of New England Hydro Finance Company, Inc. (NEHFC), a finance company formed by NEH-NH and NEH-M to facilitate the issuance and/or sale of up to \$300 million of secured and unsecured short-term notes and commercial paper, in connection with their construction financing related to the expansion of the transmission interconnection between New England Power Pool utilities and Hydro-Quebec. NEH-NH and NEH-M will guarantee the obligations of NEHFC. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the possible issuance and sale of commercial paper by NEHFC. (Rel. 35-24799 - Dec. 30, 1988)
