SIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE ENTERED AGAINST CENTURI MINING CORPORATION , AND ROC G. HATFIELD

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on December 28, 1988 U.S. District Judge William J. Costagna, Middle District of Florida, entered an Order to Show Cause Why Centuri Mining Corporation and Roc G. Hatfield Should Not Be Adjudged In Civil Contempt. A Judgment of Preliminary Injunction was entered against defendants on November 21, 1988 which continued a previously ordered freeze of assets. The Commission's Motion for an Order to Show Cause, filed December 16, 1988, alleges that defendants violated the terms of the preliminary injunction by continuing the fraudulent offer of unregistered securities, by offering to sell or pledge assets owned or controlled by defendants. The Order to Show Cause directed defendants to appear before the Court on January 24, 1989 to show cause why they should not be held in contempt for violating the terms of the Judgment of Preliminary Injunction. (SEC v. Centuri Mining Corporation, et al., Civil Action No. 88-1741-CIV-T-15B, MDFL). (LR-11968)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

FUGITIVE PENNY STOCK PROMOTER ARRESTED

The U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah and the Denver Regional and Salt Lake City Branch Offices announced that on January 3 John Worthen was arrested in Hurricane, Utah by FBI agents. Worthen has been a fugitive since December 17, 1987 when he was indicted on 12 counts of criminal contempt of a prior Commission injunction. On January 13, a U.S. Magistrate in Salt Lake City ordered that Worthen remain in custody, without being permitted to post bail, until he is removed to the Southern District of California to answer the indictment.

This prosecution targets fraud and sales of unregistered stock allegedly committed by a recidivist penny stock promoter. The indictment charges that Worthen violated the injunction by engaging in a scheme to defraud investors out of approximately \$415,000 in connection with the purchase of sale of unregistered stock of Western Pacific Technology, Inc. and Nordic Ltd., Inc., two Nevada shell companies. Worthen is alleged to have manipulated the price of the stock in the over-the-counter market through a series of transactions using nominee accounts, and to have made false public statements concerning these companies' assets and operations.
