U.S. ELOURITHES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NORTH COAST ADVISORS, INC., DAVID MYEROFF CENSURED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against North Coast Advisors, Inc., a registered investment adviser in Ohio, and David Myeroff, its president and majority shareholder. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted their Offers of Settlement in which they consented, without admitting or denying the findings in the Order, to findings that they willfully violated the antifraud and certain books and records provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. Specifically, they consented to findings that they took possession of two clients' investment funds, and unbeknownst to the clients, held the funds in North Coast's bank account for between six and twelve months before finally investing them.

North Coast and Myeroff agreed to be censured, and to comply with their undertakings to refrain from having custody or possession of clients' funds or securities and to maintain specified books and records. (Rel. IA-1152)

DECISION DENYING REGISTRATION TO AND BARRING PHILIP S. WILSON FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge denying the application of Philip S. Wilson, doing business as Wilson Associates, of Woodland Hills, California, for registration as an investment adviser, and barring him from association with any such adviser has become final. The law judge found that, in his application, Wilson omitted required information concerning his bankruptcy and two CBOE disciplinary actions, and misstated the findings against him in a third CBOE action that was affirmed by the Commission. The law judge noted that, in the third action, the Commission found that Wilson had been guilty of "egregious dishonesty." (Rel. IA-1153)

BRIAN J. LAREAU BARRED

The Commission announced that Brian J. Lareau, a former E.F. Hutton & Company, Inc. registered representative, consented, without admitting or denying the allegations, to an Order barring him from association with any broker-dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser. Lareau may apply to become reassociated in a non-proprietary, non-supervisory capacity after the greater of one year from the date of the Order or completion of his sentence in the criminal matter. The Order alleges that Lareau, among other things, (1) opened customer accounts at Hutton using false names and social security numbers; (2) assisted customers in structuring transactions in order to evade currency transaction reporting requirements; and (3) pleaded guilty in U.S. v. Brian J. Lareau [Cr. No. 88-037-B, District of Rhode Island] to falsification of social security numbers on customer accounts and causing other financial institutions to fail to file currency transaction reports in conjunction with the Bank Secrecy Act. RICHARDSON GREENSHIELDS SECURITIES INC. CENSURED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Richardson Greenshields Securities Inc., a New York City based broker-dealer, and simultaneously accepted its Offer of Settlement in which it, without admitting or denying the alleged violations, consented to a censure and an order requiring compliance with specified undertakings. The Order alleges that respondent aided and abetted violations by Kominz Company Government Securities, Inc., with which it had contracted to provide clearing services through a customer omnibus account. According to the Order, Kominz arranged for or permitted the continued hypothecation of securities carried for the account of its customers, under circumstances which permitted these customer securities to be commingled with securities carried for the account of the two Kominz principal officers (who were not bona fide customers of Kominz) under a lien for a loan made to Kominz. It was also alleged that, as a result of respondent's role in aiding and abetting this conduct, respondent willfully aided and abetted violations of Section 8(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 8c-1(a)(2). CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DISGORGEMENT ORDERED AGAINST GARY M. WOZNIAK

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on January 12 Judge George LaPlata, Eastern District of Michigan, ordered that Gary M. Wozniak disgorge the funds he deposited in the Registry of the Court, \$13,304 including interest plus other funds, assets, or property he received arising from his wrongful conduct. Wozniak had deposited the funds in the Court's registry following an earlier court order.

The August 28, 1987 Complaint alleged that Wozniak offered and sold securities to investors, requiring them to make their checks payable to Wozniak's personal bank account for the purchase of securities. Wozniak failed to process those orders and in connection therewith, misappropriated hundreds of thousands of dollars. On August 15, 1988, following the Commission's motion for partial summary judgment, Wozniak was permanently enjoined from violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Gary M. Wozniak, EDMI, Civil Action No. 87-60283AA, filed August 28, 1987). (LR-11986)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

DOY L. DANIELS, JR. SENTENCED

The Chicago Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Western District of Tennessee announced that on January 20 Doy L. Daniels, Jr. was sentenced to 10 years incarceration and ordered to pay restitution to victim investors. The underlying indictment described a fraudulent scheme in which Daniels raised \$1 million and misappropriated in excess of \$400,000. Daniels had previously pleaded guilty to seven counts of securities fraud, six counts of mail fraud, and one count of bank fraud. (U.S. Doy L. Daniels, Jr., WDTN, Criminal No. 88-20157T). (LR-11985)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PW PRIVATE CAPITAL TECHNOLOGY FUND, L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by PW Private Capital Technology Fund, L.P. (the Partnership), PaineWebber Technology Management, L.P., and PaineWebber Development Corporation (collectively, Applicants), exempting them from the provisions of Section 2(a)(19) and 2(a)(3)(D) of the Investment Company Act to the extent necessary that (1) the Independent General Partners will not be deemed "interested persons" of the Applicants solely by reason of serving as general partners of the Partnership, and (2) the limited partners owning less than 5% of limited partnership interests in the Partnership will not be deemed "affiliated persons" of other partners or the Partnership solely by reason of their status as limited partners. (Rel. IC-16787 - Feb. 1)

DSI SERIES FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting DSI Series Fund, Inc. and certain life insurance companies and variable life insurance separate accounts investing therein and principal underwriters thereof from Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) to permit mixed and shared funding. (Rel. IC-16788 - Feb. 1)

ALLSTATE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK

An order has been issued exempting Allstate Life Insurance Company of New York and Allstate Life of New York Variable Annuity Account from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account. (Rel. IC-16789 - Feb. 1)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Louisiana Power & Light Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, inc., to acquire, through a lease, nuclear fuel in the approximate amount of up to \$1.25 million. (Rel. 35-24810 - Feb. 2)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-89-3) to extend for one year its trading crowd evaluation pilot program. (Rel. 34-26507)

SUMMARY EFFECTIVENESS OF AMENDMENTS

Under Rule 11Aa3-1 and 11Aa3-2, the Consolidated Tape Association and the Consolidated Quotation System filed amendments to the Plan governing the operation of the consolidated transaction reporting system and to the Plan governing the operation of the consolidated quotation reporting system. The amendments increase Network B non-member fees for bid/ask and last sale interrogation units. (Rel. 34-26509)
