IDMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NASD SANCTIONS AGAINST CHARLES L. CAMPBELL AFFIRMED

The Commission affirmed sanctions imposed by the National Association of Securities Dealers on Charles L. Campbell, former president of First Union Securities, Inc., a Portland, Oregon brokerage firm. The NASD censured Campbell, fined him \$15,000, and barred him from association with any member firm in a principal capacity.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that Campbell was responsible for First Union's 1984 violations of net capital, customer protection, and reporting requirements, and for its improper commingling of firm and customer securities. In addition, Campbell was found responsible for the firm's violations of its agreement with the NASD restricting the size of the firm's securities inventory.

The Commission noted that Campbell "deliberately flouted the firm's agreement with the NASD limiting the size of its inventory, and refused to close down operations in the face of net capital deficiencies." It concluded that Campbell had "amply demonstrated that he is unfit to act in a principal capacity for a member firm." (Rel. 34-26510)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST WILLIAM D. FOLZ AND ROYAL FIESTA CRUISES, INC.

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices filed a civil injunctive action on January 13 in the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida against William D. Folz, of Belleaire, Florida, and Royal Fiesta Cruises, Inc., located in Clearwater, Florida. The Complaint seeks to restrain and enjoin defendants from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws, and to obtain an accounting and disgorgement of proceeds received from the scheme.

The Complaint alleges that defendants offered and sold approximately \$1.6 million of Royal's unregistered common stock to at least 270 investors residing in six states. It also alleges that defendants made misrepresentations and omissions of material facts to prospective investors concerning, among other things, Royal's acquisition and refurbishment of a cruise ship, Royal's financial condition, Royal's proposed operations, the intended use of proceeds, the nature and amount of Folz's compensation, and the value and liquidity of Royal's securities. ELAN FUNDS, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Blan Funds, Inc. permitting the issuance and sale of two classes of shares in each investment portfolio differing only in dividend record dates. (Rel. IC-16796 - Feb. 6)

LEGG MASON CASH RESERVE TRUST

An order has been issued on an application filed by Legg Mason Cash Reserve Trust, Legg Mason Income Trust, Inc., Legg Mason Special Investment Trust, Inc., Legg Mason Tax-Exempt Trust, Inc., Legg Mason Total Return Trust, Inc., and Legg Mason Value Trust, Inc., on behalf of themselves and all future investment companies which are advised or managed by Legg Mason Fund Adviser, Inc. or Western Asset Management Company (Funds), granting exemption from Section 32(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act to permit the Funds to file financial statements signed or certified by an independent public accountant selected at a Board of Directors or Trustees meeting held within 90 days before or after each Fund's fiscal year. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until February 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following company filed under Release 35-24814, dated February 3: GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION (GPU) - a registered holding company, to initially issue, through December 31, 1998, pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding, and subsequently reacquire, up to 20,000 shares of GPU common stock under a Restricted Stock Plan for Outside Directors (Plan), which is to be adopted, subject to certain restrictions, as further compensation for members of GPU's Board of Directors (Board) who are Outside Directors. The Plan is to be administered by a Committee. Outside Directors are to be awarded 100 shares of GPU common stock, or a portion thereof, with respect to service in 1989 and, beginning in 1990, in an

amount to be determined by the Board upon recommendation of the Committee.

GPU also proposes to solicit proxies for the 1989 Annual Meeting of its shareh..ders to be held on or about May 3, 1989 in connection with requesting shareholder approval of the Plan. Subject to approval, the Plan would be effective as of January 1, 1989.

ELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by: The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-88-32) to increase the supplemental listing fee and annual fee imposed on Amex-listed company equity issues. (Rel. 34-26520); and The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-87-38) to revise, restate, and consolidate its Specialist Job Description and the Code of Acceptable Business Practices for Specialists. (Rel. 34-26523)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-CBOE-89-2) updates examples based on recent position limits and reflects existing Exchange responsibilities for position limits. (Rel. 34-26521)
