EXCHANGE COMMISSION

PROTEST FOR EDGAR OPERATIONAL CONTRACT WITHDRAWN

The Commission announced today that a protest filed by an unsuccessful offeror for the EDGAR Operational contract was withdrawn on February 8, and the General Services Board of Contract Appeals lifted a temporary suspension of performance on that date. On January 3, the Commission awarded the EDGAR contract to The BDM Corporation, bidding with Mead Data Central, Inc., Sorg Incorporated, and Bechtel Information Services.

Performance has resumed under the contract and, despite an approximate one month delay in the development schedule, the first Pilot filers are still expected to begin filing on Operational EDGAR in mid-1990. ### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST LAS VEGAS PENNY STOCK FIRM, OTHERS

The Chicago Regional Office filed a Complaint on February 3 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada seeking preliminary and permanent injunctions and other equitable relief against Stoneridge Securities, Inc., Composite Design, Inc. (formerly SRS Technical, Inc.), CTI Technical, Inc., Ronald D. Wheeler, Sr., Ronald D. Wheeler, Jr., Randy Gleich, Brenda Kross, Norman L. Vance, and Edwin (Bud) Wheeler. The Commission's 12-count Complaint alleges, among other things, violations and aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud, registration, reporting, recordkeeping, financial responsibility, and prospectus delivery provisions of the securities laws. It also alleges that the penny stock broker, Stoneridge and its principals, through a complex scheme, manipulated the price of the stock of two blind pool issuers, SRS and CTI. The stock of these companies was listed in the "pink sheets" and was inflated by more than 1000% in sales to the public.

Gleich submitted an Offer of Settlement in which he consents, without admitting or denying liability, to an order of permanent injunction. (SEC v. Stoneridge Securities, Inc., et al., USDC DNV, Civil Action No. 5-89-096). (LR-11995)

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY CARL PORTO SHOULD NOT BE HELD IN CIVIL CONTEMPT ENTERED

The Chicago Regional Office filed a Motion for an Order to Show Cause Why Carl Porto Should Not Be Held in Civil Contempt based on his failure to comply with the Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief entered against him on June 24, 1988. U.S. Magistrate Joan Gottschaal, Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, issued an Order to Show Cause Why Carl Porto Should Not Be Held in Civil Contempt on January 24. A March 8 hearing has been set.

The Final Judgment ordered Porto to disgorge \$150,000 and incorporated an 18-month payment plan calling for monthly installments of \$8,333.33 to begin on September 1, 1988 and continuing through February 1, 1990 to be paid into the Registry of the Court. To date, Porto has failed to make any of the ordered payments. Porto consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's January 1988 Complaint. The Final Judgment permanently enjoined Porto from, among other things, violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws, and also ordered him to make disgorgement. (SEC v. Carl Porto, et al., NDIL, Civil Action No. 88 C 0239). (LR-11996)

## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

## **ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES**

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the prior percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
