ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

NASD SANCTIONS AGAINST L. C. THOMAS AND STEPHEN V. WALLACE AFFIRMED

The Commission affirmed sanctions imposed by the NASD on L. C. Thomas, of New Milford, New Jersey, and Stephen V. Wallace, of Park Ridge, New Jersey, who were associated with an NASD member firm. The NASD suspended Thomas and Wallace from association with any member for two years. Thereafter, they must requalify by examination for any registered capacity in which they seek to become associated.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that, at Thomas's request, Wallace posed as Thomas and took the NASD's General Securities Representative (Series 7) Examination. The Commission stated that "the examination process provides a basic protection for the investing public" and, noting the extreme seriousness with which it views misconduct of the type committed by respondents, found the sanctions imposed on them "fully warranted in the public interest." PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST LESLIE H. ROBERTS

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Leslie H. Roberts of Miami, Florida, formerly a registered representative employed consecutively by two registered broker-dealers in Miami and Boca Raton, Florida, respectively. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement submitted by Roberts. In his Offer of Settlement, Roberts consents to, and the Commission entered: (a) findings that Roberts violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act and that he was convicted of conspiracy and mail fraud in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida; and (b) an Order barring Roberts from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company.

The Commission found that Roberts violated the antifraud provisions by engaging in unauthorized transactions in a customer's account. Roberts concealed those transactions by diverting the customer's real confirmations and monthly account statements from the customer's correct address and providing the customer with false confirmations and monthly account statements. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

STAR-COM I, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on January 17 Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction were entered in the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee against SCN, Ltd., headquartered in Reno Nevada, and its subsidiary, Star-Com Network, Ltd. The defendants previously enjoined in the same action were Star-Com I Limited, purportedly an Arizona limited partnership; Transcom I, a Michigan partnership; Jamie, Inc., a corporation organized in Nevada; Maurice W. Furlong of Reno, Nevada; James Troester of Prairie Village, Kansas; Samuel D. Johnson of Riverdale, Georgia; and William R. Schilling of Allendale, Michigan. All defendants consented to the September 29, 1988 Complaint without admitting or denying the allegations.

The Complaint alleged that defendants sold limited partnerships interests in Star-Com I Limited, partnership interests in Transcom I, and common stock of SCN in violation of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

Alleged misstatements and omissions of material fact included the safety of the investment, the existence of contracts for goods and services, the rate of return on the investment, the use of proceeds, the financial condition of the issuer, the ownership of securities sold, and background information on the management. (SEC v. Star-Com I Limited, et al., USDC MDTN, Civil Action No. 3:88-0818-Biggins/Sandidge). (LR-11997)

CALIFORNIA-WESTERN STATES LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

The application also requests an order exempting Applicants from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of restructured Account A. NATIONWIDE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 10 to request a hearing on an application filed by Nationwide Life Insurance Company, Nationwide Variable Account-4, and Smith Barney, Harris Upham & Co. Incorporated for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of Variable Account-4.
