ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST NICHOLAS A. BOCCELLA

The Commission yesterday instituted proceedings under Sections 15(b)(4)(E) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Nicholas A. Boccella to determine whether he failed reasonably to supervise persons subject to his supervision and, if so, what remedial action should be taken. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Boccella's Offer of Settlement in which he agreed to the imposition of a censure and, in lieu of any supervisory responsibilities, to spend four weeks receiving training in subjects relating to compliance and customer protection.

Boccella was branch manager for E.F. Hutton and Company, Inc. in Richmond, Virginia. Boccella's failure to supervise related to the misconduct of Clyde B. Pitchford, Jr., a registered representative subject to Boccella's supervision who, from June 1983 to February 1986, misappropriated more than \$740,000 worth of funds and securities from his E.F. Hutton customers. The Commission found that Boccella failed reasonably to supervise Pitchford by, among other things, failing to follow internal firm procedures relating to disbursements of checks for hand delivery to customers and oversight of transactions involving employee-related accounts. (Rel. 34-26574)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST WILLIAM L. VIEIRA

The Commission today instituted proceedings under Sections 15(b)(4)(E) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against William A. Vieira to determine whether he failed reasonably to supervise persons subject to his supervision and, if so, what remedial action should be taken. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Vieria's Offer of Settlement in which he agreed to the imposition of a censure and, in lieu of any supervisory responsibilities, to spend four weeks receiving training in subjects relating to compliance and customer protection.

Vieria was branch manager for E.F. Hutton and Company, Inc. in Modesto, California. Vieria's failure to supervise related to the misconduct of Paul G. White, a registered representative subject to Vieria's supervision who, from February 1984 to March 1986, misappropriated more than \$175,000 worth of funds and securities from 24 accounts he serviced. The Commission found that Vieria failed reasonably to supervise White by, among other things, failing to follow internal firm procedures relating to disbursements of checks for hand delivery to customers. (Rel. 34-26576)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ISSUED AGAINST HABERSHEIR SECURITIES, INC.

The Atlanta Regional Office filed a Complaint on February 13 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia seeking a temporary restraining order and preliminary and permanent injunctions against Habersheir Securities, Inc., a registered broker-dealer headquartered in Atlanta. The Complaint alleges that Habersheir is currently operating while failing to maintain required net capital; that Habersheir failed to make, keep current, and preserve books and records as required; and that Habersheir failed to file with the Commission its annual audited report for 1988 and to give required telegraphic notice. After a hearing on February 14, Judge Jack T. Camp issued a temporary restraining order. (SEC v. Habersheir Securiteies, Inc., Civil Action No. 1:89-CV-298-JTC, USDC NDGA). (LR-12008)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

ALVIN A. DESHANO INDICTED

The Los Angeles Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California announced that on February 16 an indictment was returned against Alvin A. DeShano. DeShano was the director of general accounting for Carl Karcher Enterprises, Inc. (CKE) during all relevant times, and was charged with insider trading in that stock. Specifically, the indictment charges that, on October 12, 1984, DeShano received material, adverse financial information about the company. Thereafter, on October 15, 1984, DeShano sold 1,725 shares of CKE stock at \$23 per share. On October 23, 1984, CKE publicly announced its lowered earnings for the period in question. By selling before this announcement, DeShano avoided losses of approximately \$7,107. Based on this misconduct, DeShano is charged with violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. (U.S. v. Alvin A. DeShano, No. CR 89-117, CDCA). (LR-12006)

DAVID KEN YOSHINAGA AND INVESTMENTS MANAGEMENT COMPANY, INC. INDICTED

The Denver Regional Office, the Office of the U.S. Attorney for the District of Colorado, and the U.S. Postal Inspection Service, announced on February 14 the indictment of David Ken Yoshinaga and Investments Management Company, Inc. The indictment alleges ten counts of mail fraud and one count of fraud under the Investment Advisers Act. It also alleges that Yoshinaga misrepresented the profits from investments and that he misappropriated \$900,000 of his clients' funds.

On May 1, 1984, an order was entered against Yoshinaga permanently enjoining him and two of his companies from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. On April 10, 1986, he was held in contempt of a court order ordering him to turn over \$933,933.15 of investor monies to the Commission. Since that time he has been a fugitive. (U.S. v. David Ken Yoshinaga, et al., USDC CO, 89-CR-048). (LR-12007)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BOUUS CAPITAL PARTNERS, L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Equus Capital Partners, L.P. (Partnership) and Equus Capital Corporation (Adviser) for an order determining that: (1) the Independent General Partners of the Partnership are not "interested persons", within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act, of the Partnership or the Adviser, and (2) the limited partners who own less than 5% of equity interest in the Partnership will not be deemed "affiliated persons" (as defined by Section 2(a)(3)(D) of the Act) of the Partnership or other partners solely by reason of their being limited partners. (Rel. IC-16830 - Feb. 22)

EBI SERIES TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 15 to request a hearing on an application filed by EBI Series Trust, EBI Equity, Inc., EBI Income, Inc., and EBI Cash Management, Inc., seeking an order amending a prior order [Rel. IC-16283, February 23, 1988) to permit certain modifications of a contingent deferred sales load. (Rel. IC-16831 - Feb. 22)

ML VENTURE PARTNERS II, L.P.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 20 to request a hearing on an application filed by ML Venture Partners II, L.P., Merrill Lynch Venture Capital Inc., ML Technology Ventures, L.P., Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1987, and KECALP Inc., for an order exempting certain transactions from Sections 17(a) and 57(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act, and authorizing transactions otherwise prohibited by Sections 17(d) and 57(a)(4) of the Act. (Rel. IC-16832 - Feb. 22)

PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission partially approved a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-88-21) to modify certain obligations of Registered Option Traders. (Rel. 34-26568)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Government Securities Clearing Corporation. The proposal (SR-GSCC-88-3) authorizes GSCC to require applicants for membership in and members of GSCC to submit financial information to GSCC for use in assessing each applicant's and member's financial responsibility. (Rel. 34-26569)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-CBOE-89-4) that would (a) narrow the bid/offer differential for option series where the bid is less than \$2; (b) create a pilot program whereby a disseminated market quote would become a firm quote for ten contracts by a trading crowd; and (c) change the format of Chapter VIII of the Exchange rules. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 27. (Rel. 34-26570)
