ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SANCTIONS IMPOSED ON RICHARD E. MOYER, OTHERS

Administrative Law Judge Brenda P. Murray issued an initial decision barring Richard E. Moyer from association with any broker-dealer provided that he may reapply after one year for association in a non-supervisory and non-proprietary capacity, suspending T. Marshall Swartwood, president of Swartwood Hesse, from association with any broker or dealer in a supervisory capacity for 90 days, and censuring the New York City firm of Swartwood Hesse, a registered broker-dealer.

The decision finds that Moyer aided and abetted Swartwood Hesse's violation of Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-6, that he violated Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5, and that Swartwood and Swartwood Hesse violated Sections 15(b)(4)(E) and 15(b)(6). Respondents' actions occurred in late 1983 in connection with the initial public offering and aftermarket in securities of Software Services of America, Inc.

The decision will become final within 15 days of service as to each party who does not file for review or unless the Commission decides on its own initiative to review the decision.

PROCEEDINGS ORDERED AGAINST WILLIAM H. MATHIS

The Commission instituted an administrative proceeding against William H. Mathis under Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 based upon the prior entry of a permanent injunction against him [SEC v. W. Paul Thayer, et al., CA3-84-0471-R, NDTX]. Pursuant to the settlement entered into in the injunctive action, the only issue to be determined in the administrative proceeding will be what sanction, if any, should be levied against Mathis.

On November 16, 1988, the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas entered a permanent injunction against Mathis. The injunction enjoins him from future violations of Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3. Mathis consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint, to the injunction and to the administrative proceeding under Section 15(b) of the Exchange Act. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST PAUL B. METZINGER

The Los Angeles Regional and San Francisco Branch Offices announced that on February 23 the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado entered a Final Order of Permanent Injunction against Paul H. Metzinger, a Denver-based attorney. The order permanently restrains and enjoins Metzinger from violating certain provisions of the securities laws, including the registration, antifraud, antimanipulation, issuer-reporting, issuer-accounting, securities-ownership reporting, and broker-dealer registration provisions. Metzinger consented to the order, which settles two Commission enforcement actions against him. (SEC v. Dynapac, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 87-Z-1130; SEC v. Metzinger, Civil Action No. 89-Z-227). (LR-12020)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ORDER NAMES WILLIAM H. BARTLETT, OTHERS

The Chicago Regional Office filed a Complaint on February 28 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois seeking a Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief against William H. Bartlett, Rick E. Myers, Continental Financial Services, and Michigan Dairy Services for violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The Complaint alleges that defendants, between 1981 and 1985, raised over \$8 million in the offer and sale of unregistered securities in the form of investment contracts in a dairy cattle leasing program to over 200 investors in 23 states. It also alleges that defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions concerning the return on the investment; the use of proceeds; the relationship between the issuer, supplier, inspection service, and lessee; and the risk associated with the investment.

Defendants, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against them. (SEC v. William H. Bartlett, et al., NDIL, Civil Action No. 89-C-1648). (LR-12021)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

DAVID L. WILLIAMS FOUND GUILTY

The Boston Regional Office and the Attorney General of the State of New Hampshire announced that on February 28 a Hillsborough County jury returned a guilty verdict against David L. Williams of Manchester, New Hampshire on six counts of theft in seven counts of securities fraud. The state charges were brought against Williams in connection with his activities as a real estate developer and investment adviser. Sentencing is to be imposed within 30 days.

Williams previously pleaded guilty to three federal charges of mail and investment adviser fraud and was sentenced to six years imprisonment. Williams had yet to begin his federal sentence, which was delayed until after his trial on state charges.

In an earlier civil action by the Commission, Williams was enjoined from further violations of registration, reporting, and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Commission also barred Williams from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser. (State of New Hampshire v. David L. Williams, Hillsborough County Superior Court, Indictment No. 87-S-679). (LR-12019)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE OTC-100 FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by The OTC-100 Fund, Inc. for a permanent injunction permitting it to suspend the right of redemption through March 22, 1989 to enable it to effect an orderly sale of assets and distribution of proceeds to security holders in contemplation of the liquidation and dissolution of Applicant. A temporary order permitting Applicant to suspend through March 15, 1989 the right of redemption, and payments upon redemptions previously received, has been issued under Section 22(e)(3) of the Investment Company Act. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

A notice have been issued giving interested persons until March 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following company filed under Release 35-24830, dated March 2: THE SOUTHERN COMPANY - a registered holding company, and two of its subsidiaries, Gulf Power Company and Mississippi Power Company, through March 31, 1991 for (1) Southern to make capital contributions to Gulf, Mississippi, and Georgia Power Company, another subsidiary of Southern, in the aggregate amounts of \$10 million, \$20 million, and \$200 million, respectively; and (2) Gulf and Mississippi to issue and sell from time to time up to the aggregate principal amount of \$50 million for Gulf and \$120 million for Mississippi short-term notes to banks, commercial paper to dealers and/or short-term non-negotiable promissory notes to public entities in connection with the financing of certain pollution control facilities through the issuance by public entities of their revenue bond anticipation notes.

In addition, Mississippi proposes to submit to the holders of its outstanding preferred stock for consideration and action at a special meeting of such holders to be held on about May 16, 1989, a proposal that Mississippi be authorized, until July 1, 1999, to issue or assume unsecured debt having maturities of less than ten years in excess of 10% of capital stock, surplus and secured debt.
