COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FOIA APPEAL OF MICHAEL D. DONOVAN, ESQ.

The General Counsel sent a letter to Michael D. Donovan, Esq., granting access to preliminary proxy materials and staff comment letters thereon in connection with a proposed management-led leveraged buyout of Budget Rent-A-Car Corp. (Budget). The General Counsel determined, in light of Budget's filing of definitive proxy materials, these materials were not exempt from disclosure under FOIA Exemption 4, 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(4), 17 C.F.R. 200.80(b)(4). ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

LARRY A. DIXON SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Larry A. Dixon, a certified public accountant of Spokane, Washington. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Dixon's Offer of Settlement in which he was permanently denied the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission.

The administrative proceedings were based on a finding that Dixon had been enjoined in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Washington from aiding and abetting violations of registration and antifraud provisions [Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 10b-5] in connection with the securities of Colonial International Import, Ltd., Tri-Lite Corporation, and Computime Computer Services, Inc. (Rel. 33-6826)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AGAINST MARK L. STAHL

Public administrative proceedings have been ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Mark L. Stahl, a former registered representative of Shearson Lehman Brothers, Inc. The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that June 18, 1987, Stahl was convicted in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York of wire and mail fraud.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Stahl are true, and if so, to decide what, if any, remedial action is appropriate. (Rel. 34-26633)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

KEITH S. SHELDON PLEADS GUILTY

The U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia and the Atlanta Regional Office announced that on February 22, before Chief Judge William C. O'Kelly, Keith S. Sheldon of Hiawassee, Georgia pleaded guilty to one count of securities fraud and one count of mail fraud. Sentencing is set for 9:30 a.m. on April 28, 1989 in Gainesville, Georgia. Sheldon faces a maximum sentence of ten years in prison, a fine of \$500,000 and restitution of \$25,050.

The plea was the result of an investigation by the Commission and the U.S. Attorney's Office, which charged that, from on or about August 1 to on or about October 5, 1988, Sheldon, while employed as a registered representative with R.B. Marich, Inc., solicited in excess of \$25,000 from investors. The plea charges that Sheldon, for the purpose of deceiving and defrauding investors and to induce them to invest, misrepresented and made false statements of material facts, concerning, among other things, that:
(a) funds would be invested in the investors' names: (b) investor funds would be and were used to purchase 3,000 shares of Sea Venture Cruises, Inc. common stock; (c) the investment in Sea Venture Cruises, Inc. common stock would net a 19.8% return within 30 to 90 days; and (d) the Sea Venture Cruises, Inc. investment had been structured by R.B. Marich, Inc. (U.S. v. Keith S. Sheldon, CR-88-21G, U.S.D.C. N.D. GA) (LR-12037)
