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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### MARTIN A. KUPERBERG NAMED ASSOCIATE REGIONAL ADMINISTRATOR

New York Regional Administrator Lawrence Iason announced earlier this month the appointment of Martin A. Kuperberg as Associate Regional Administrator in charge of the Broker-Dealer Inspection Program, the Branch of Small Issues, and the Branch of Broker-Dealer Enforcement and Interpretations. Mr. Kuperberg succeeds Edwin Nordlinger, who is now Deputy Regional Administrator.

Mr. Kuperberg is a graduate of Adelphi University. He joined the staff of the New York Regional Office in 1973 and has been promoted to successively more important positions -- Senior Examiner, Branch Chief, Chief of the Broker-Dealer Section Program, Assistant Regional Administrator, and Deputy Associate Regional Administrator. He was a recipient of the Commission's Distinguished Service Award in 1987.

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### JAMES E. CAVALLO SANCTIONED

The Commission barred James E. Cavallo, of Brooklyn, New York, from association with any broker or dealer with the proviso that, after 18 months, he may apply to become so associated in a non-proprietary, non-supervisory capacity, upon a satisfactory showing of adequate supervision.

The Commission found that, in December 1980 and the early months of 1981, Cavallo made fraudulent representations to customers in connection with his sale of stock in Reserve Oil and Minerals Corporation. In imposing the sanction, the Commission stated that "Cavallo's sales practices amounted to an abdication of the responsibilities imposed on professionals in the securities business." 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### MOTION TO RECONSIDER SUMMARY JUDGMENT AGAINST WILLIAM A. CALVO, III DENIED

The Boston Regional Office announced that on March 14 Judge Peter C. Dorsey, U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut, entered an Order denying an AMENDED MOTION TO SET ASIDE AND/OR RECONSIDER SUMMARY JUDGMENT AND FOR A TRIAL AND MOTION FOR STAY PENDING APPEAL filed by William A. Calvo, III. Calvo based his motion on claimed new evidence, which Judge Dorsey determined failed to raise any new factual issues or exculpate Calvo.

On June 7, 1988, Judge Dorsey granted the Commission's Motion for Summary Judgment against Calvo. A Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered on June 9, 1988 enjoining Calvo, an attorney and member of the bars of Florida and New York, from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and Rules 10b-5 and 10b-9.

Calvo's motion to stay the injunction pending appeal was also denied. (SEC v. The Electronics Warehouse, Inc., et al., DCT, Civil Action No. H-86-282, PCD). (LR-12045)

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## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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### E. ALBERT BOONE, OTHERS SENTENCED

The Seattle Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office in Boise, Idaho announced that on March 10 E. Albert Boone, Dehlia E. Boone, and Jerry A. Boone of Placerville, Idaho, and Roger D. Swayze of Las Vegas, Nevada, were sentenced on convictions found earlier for one or more of the following offenses committed in connection with mining property offerings in Idaho: securities fraud; sale of unregistered securities; mail fraud; interstate transportation of stolen property; false statements; false declaration to a grand jury; tax evasion; and conspiracy. For their respective violations, E. Boone was sentenced to two years imprisonment, J. Boone was given a suspended sentence with five years probation, and Swayze received one year imprisonment.
