## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### COMMISSION ACCEPTS OFFER OF SETTLEMENT FROM SALOMON BROTHERS INC.

The Commission simultaneously instituted and settled administrative proceedings against Salomon Brothers Inc., a registered broker-dealer located in New York, New York.

Salomon, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Final Order) which finds that on October 19, 1987, Salomon violated the short sale provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by effecting, for its own account, 70 sales transactions in 19 New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) securities, involving approximately 300,000 shares of stock with a market value of approximately \$12.5 million, while it was "net short" in those 19 securities, and (1) failed to mark the orders relating to such transactions as short sales, and (2) effected those short sales on the NYSE on improper "ticks."

The Final Order further finds that Salomon violated the Exchange Act by failing to promptly provide certain of its required records to members of the Commission staff. It also censures Salomon and orders it to implement and comply with certain undertakings. (Rel. 34-26838)

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### STEPHEN L. READ AGREES TO \$75,000 FINE AND INJUNCTION, THE ROLFITE COMPANY TO BE ENJOINED AND DEREGISTERED

The Commission announced that on May 23 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia (Judge Charles R. Richey) issued an Order accepting a settlement which would resolve the Commission's civil contempt proceedings against The Rolfite Company and its president, chairman, and majority shareholder, Stephen L. Read. Under the terms of the settlement, (1) Read agreed to pay \$75,000 in fines to the U.S. Treasury for civil contempt, of which \$50,000 has already been paid and the remainder is due by June 5, for failure to cause Rolfite to file certain reports; (2) Rolfite agreed to consent to an injunction against violations of Section 13(b)(2)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934; (3) Read agreed to consent to an injunction against aiding and abetting any issuers' future violations of Section 13(b)(2)(A); and (4) Rolfite agreed to consent to the deregistration of its securities under Section 12(j) of the Exchange Act. (SEC v. The Rolfite Company, Civil Action No. 87-0881-CRR, DDC 1987, and SEC v. Stephen L. Read, Civil Action No. 87-3006-CRR, DDC 1987). (LR-12107; AAER-227)

### INJUNCTION SOUGHT AGAINST NATIONAL GAS & POWER COMPANY, INC., OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional Office filed a civil action on May 12 in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of North Carolina seeking to enjoin National Gas & Power Company, Inc., Joseph A. DiBruno, and Virginia L. Ingle from violating the registration, antifraud, and other provisions of the securities laws. The Complaint alleges that beginning in 1983 and continuing to date, defendants sold about 5.5 million shares of unregistered National common stock to almost 200 persons in 19 states, for about \$2 million. It also alleges that defendants arbitrarily sold the stock for prices ranging from \$.25 to \$1.00 a share, and misrepresented or omitted material facts concerning, among other things, its financial condition, contracts, and acquisitions. It further alleges that National, aided and abetted by DiBruno, failed to file or timely file annual, quarterly, and current reports and that DiBruno failed to file reports respecting his acquisition and disposition of National stock. It is alleged also that Ingle violated the broker-dealer registration provisions. (SEC v. National Gas & Power Company, et al., USDC WDNC, Civil Action No. 89-207-M). (LR-12104)

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### QUEST FOR VALUE FAMILY OF FUNDS

### NOVA FUNDS GROUP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 12 to request a hearing on an application filed by Nova Funds Group for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16970 - May 19)

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### THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-89-3) that increases initial and minimum net capital requirements imposed by OCC on its members. The proposal also revises OCC's early warning notice requirement and its authority to restrict member activities, transactions, positions, and distributions. (Rel. 34-26840)

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-89-6) to amend its minor disciplinary rule plan. (Rel. 34-26852); and The Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-89-1) to amend Rule 11.9(c) so as to permit its Securities Committee to assign the obligation of guaranteeing public agency order executions to one Designated Dealer in a new National Securities Trading System issue. (Rel. 34-26853)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 22.

#### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-DTC-89-10) modifies the fee schedule for certain DTC services involving the Institutional Delivery System. (Rel. 34-26854)
