RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

RULE 19c-5 ADOPTED

The Commission adopted Rule 19c-5 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and issued for comment a staff White Paper on Market Structure questions relating to options multiple trading. Rule 19c-5, which becomes effective on January 22, 1990, amends the rules on national securities exchanges to permit the multiple trading of options on exchange listed stocks. The Rule contains a phased-in implementation schedule. Specifically, commencing January 22, 1990, (1) an options exchange can list up to ten classes of standardized put and call options overlying exchange-listed stocks that were also listed on another options exchange on or before January 22, 1990, and (2) any new options class first listed on any exchange on or after January 22, 1990, can be multiply traded. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST MATTHEWS & WRIGHT, INC., OTHERS

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings against Matthews & Wright, Inc. (M&W Inc.), George W. Benoit, and Roger J. Burns. Simultaneously, and pursuant to their Offers of Settlement, the Commission, based on Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction in SEC v. Matthews & Wright Group, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 89-2877 (SDNY), revoked M&W Inc.'s broker-dealer registration, barred Benoit from association with any registered entity with a right to reapply in four years, and barred Burns from association with any registered entity with a right to reapply in two years. (Rel. 34-26841, 34-26842, 34-26843)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST MATTHEWS & WRIGHT, INC., OTHERS

The Commission announced that on May 4 U.S. District Court Judge Robert Ward, Southern District of New York, entered Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against Matthews & Wright Group, Inc. (M&W), its wholly-owned broker-dealer subsidiary in municipal securities, Matthews & Wright, Inc. (M&W Inc.), its President and Chairman, George W. Benoit, and its Chief Financial Officer, Poger J. Burns, for violations of and aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud, reporting, books and records, and internal controls provisions of the securities laws, rules thereunder, and related rules of the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board. Each defendant consented to the Final Judgments without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint. The Complaint also named Arthur Abba Goldberg, M&W's Executive Vice President, and Bernard M. Althoff, the companies' principal outside counsel, as defendants. The Commission's litigation as to Goldberg and Althoff is continuing.

The Complaint alleges that the violations stem from a fraudulent scheme to conduct sham closings of more than \$1.2 billion of municipal bonds prior to tax law changes in December 1985 and again in August 1986. It also alleges that M&W's public offering of its equity securities in August 1986 was based on a description of its business operations and financial condition which omitted to disclose matters concerning the nature of the closings and certain matters concerning use of proceeds of bond offerings. (SEC v. Matthews & Wright, Inc., et al., SDNY, Civil Action No. 89-2877). (LR-12072)

COMPLAINT NAMES SEYMOUR G. RUDERMAN

The New York Regional Office yesterday filed a Complaint in the Southern District of New York seeking permanent injunctive relief, disgorgement, and payment of a civil penalty against Seymour G. Ruderman, also known as "Rudy Ruderman," based upon allegations that he purchased securities while in possession of material non-public information.

The Complaint alleges that, at the time of the events described in the Complaint, Ruderman was editor of broadcast operations for <u>BusinessWeek</u>. Ruderman is alleged to have purchased the securities of companies that he knew were to be the subject of favorable articles in upcoming editions of <u>BusinessWeek</u>.

In December 1988, Ruderman pleaded guilty to two counts of mail fraud.

Without admitting or denying the Complaint's allegations, Ruderman consented to a permanent injunction prohibiting him from violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. Ruderman agreed to disgorge his illegal trading profits and pay a civil penalty under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. A Final Judgment has been submitted to the Court for approval. (SEC v. Seymour G. Ruderman, aka "Rudy Ruderman, USDC SDNY, 89 Civ. 3569, RWS). (LR-12109)
