COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CORRECTION RE OPEN MEETING

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PATRICK ROONEY APPEAL DENIED; BAR TAKES EFFECT

The Commission announced that, pursuant to an Order of the Commission, dated December 20, 1988, In the Matter of Patrick Rooney, Exchange Act Release No. 26372, Patrick Rooney is barred from association with any broker or dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer effective January 10, 1989. On that date, the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit upheld Mr. Rooney's felony convictions for filing a false tax return and conspiracy to defraud the United States government. Mr. Rooney may reapply for association after three years.

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED, SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST
BROWNSTONE-SMITH SECURITIES CORP. AND MICHAEL L. DONNELLY

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Brownstone-Smith Securities Corp. and Michael L. Donnelly. Brownstone is a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. Until it recently ceased operations, Brownstone's offices were located in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Simultaneously with the institution of the proceedings, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement by Brownstone and Donnelly. The Offer of Settlement consents to, and the Commission entered: (a) findings that Brownstone and Donnelly violated the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and the Securities Act of 1933 and the broker-dealer books and records provisions of the Exchange Act, and that a final judgment of permanent injunction was entered against them, enjoining them from violating those provisions; (b) an order revoking Brownstone's registration, and barring Donnelly, from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company, provided that he may reapply to become so associated after three years.

The Commission found that Brownstone and Donnelly violated the antifraud provisions by charging excessive and undisclosed mark-ups to retail purchasers of securities in approximately seven hundred transactions. The mark-ups ranged from 10 per cent to 166 per cent. Brownstone also failed to maintain records indicating the time at which securities transactions were ordered or effected. (Rel. 34-26936)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BEAR, STEARNS & CO.

An order has been issued on an application by Bear, Stearns & Co., Inc., on behalf of Municipal Securities Trust, High Income Series (the "Trust") under Sections 17(b) and 45(a) of the Investment Company Act of 1940, granting an exemption from Section 17(a) to permit it as sponsor of the Trust to purchase certain specified securities from the Trust and granting confidential treatment for certain information regarding such securities. (Rel. IC-17024 - June 22)

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 17 to request a hearing on an application by The Equitable Trust for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 granting exemptions from Sections 13(a)(2), 18(f)(1), 22(f), and 22(g) and pursuant to Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to implement a deferred compensation plan for its trustees. (Rel. IC-17025 - June 22)

BAILARD, BIEHL & KAISER INTERNATIONAL FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by Bailard, Biehl & Kaiser International Fund, Inc. (Applicant) for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 retroactively exempting Applicant from the provisions of Sections 18(d), 18(f), 22(c) and 22(d) and Rule 22c-1 thereunder in connection with (1) the sale of Applicant's shares beyond the amount authorized by its Certificate of Incorporation, (2) the subsequent recission offer to holders of such shares, and (3) the issuance of duly authorized shares to replace the overissued shares. (Rel. IC-17026 - June 22)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES

The Commission has issued a Memorandum Opinion and Order authorizing a plan under Section 11(e) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 submitted by NORTH-EAST UTILITIES (Northeast), a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiary companies, (1) Connecticut Light and Power Company, (2) Northeast Utilities Service Company, (3) The Rocky River Realty Company, (4) The Mohawk Gas Company, (5) Housatonic Corporation, Northeast's newly organized nonutility subsidiary company, and by (6) Yankee Energy System, Inc. (Yankee Energy), Northeast's newly organized subsidiary gas holding company, and (7) NorConn Properties, Inc., Yankee Energy's newly organized nonutility subsidiary. By this action the Commission is authorizing the organization of Yankee Energy as a new gas holding company system, the transfer and sale of the Northeast system's gas utility business to the Yankee Energy system, and the divestiture of Northeast's gas utility business by means of a pro rata distribution of Yankee Energy common stock by Northeast to its common shareholders, and related transactions. MAINE YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY; COLUMBUS SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY; CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION AND ENERGY INITIATIVES

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until July 17 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24909 dated June 22: MAINE YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY, a subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, both registered holding companies, to enter into and borrow under a revolving credit agreement with a syndicate of commercial banks, up to \$50 million through August 31, 1992. Maine Yankee further proposes to enter into and borrow under a Eurodollar Revolving Credit Agreement with a syndicate of international banks up to \$20 million through August 31, 1992; COLUMBUS SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY (CSPC), an electric public utility subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, to sell to CSPC's industrial customer, Fisher Guide Division - General Motors Corporation, for a purchase price of \$560,736 in cash, certain transformation equipment and other related equipment located at CSPC's GM Substation No. 63 in Columbus, Ohio; CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION (CSW), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary companies, Central Power and Light Company, Public Service Company of Oklahoma, Southwestern Electric Power Company, West Texas Utilities Company, Transok, Inc. and Central and South West Services, Inc., to amend their short-term borrowing program, through March 31, 1991, to permit Transok to issue short-term notes to the CSW system money pool and banks, in outstanding amounts of up to \$120 million; and ENERGY INITIATIVES, INC. (EII), an indirect subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to acquire, either directly or indirectly through a limited partnership (Partnership) to be formed for that purpose, a New York Corporation (Cogen Corp) engaged in the development of a proposed 40 MW natural gasfired cogeneration facility in New York State, which is a qualifying facility under PURPA. EII further proposes to organize a wholly owned subsidiary corporation which would be both the general and a limited partner of the Partnership. It is proposed that the Partnership will acquire all of the outstanding shares of common stock of Cogen Corp for a total purchase price not to exceed \$6 million.

AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC. (AEP), a registered holding company, and two of its subsidiary companies, AEP Generating Company (AEGCo) and Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), clarifying the meaning of the term Prime Rate as it is used in the interim financing proposal in connection with the sale and leaseback by AEGCo and I&M of their respective 50% undivided ownership interests in Rockport Generating Station Unit No. 2. (Rel. 35-24910)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

DELISTINGS GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration the Class A common stock, par value \$1, and the Class B common stock, par value \$1, of THE KEY COMPANY. (Rel. 34-26950); and the common stock, par value 1¢ of NEW WORLD ENTERTAINMENT, LTD. (Rel. 34-26955)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-89-33) relating to the responsibility of specialists and registered options traders to make ten-up markets. (Rel. 34-26943); The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-89-09) to amend its procedures governing the appeal of floor citations (Rel. 34-26944) and (SR-PSE-89-10) establishing new procedures for setting option margin levels. (Rel. 34-26945); and The American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-89-13) establishing new procedures for setting option margin levels. (Rel. 34-26946). Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 19.

NOTICE OF AMENDED PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Stock Clearing Corporation of Philadelphia filed an amended proposed rule change (SR-SCCP-87-3) that would permit SCCP to guarantee at an earlier time the settlement of trades in its Continuous Net Settlement (CNS) system and revise its CNS clearing fund formula. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 19. (Rel. 34-26954)

APPROVAL AND ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-89-03) and the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-89-01) relating to sales practice and suitability rules concerning uncovered short options transactions. The Commission also approved, on an accelerated basis, proposed rule changes filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-89-17), Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-89-24), and Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-89-14) also relating to sales practice and suitability rules concerning uncovered short options transactions. (Rel. 34-26952)

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
