COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

DANIEL L. GOELZER TESTIFIES AT HEARING ON CIVIL RICO REFORM

> The Commission today released General Counsel Daniel L. Goelzer's testimony, on behalf of the Commission, at a hearing on H.R. 1046, the "RICO Reform Act of 1989." The hearing was held before the Subcommittee on Crime of the House Committee on the Judiciary. Mr. Goelzer's testimony recommends limitations on the availability of treble recovery in private civil RICO actions based on violations of the securities laws.

> The testimony notes that private damage actions under the securities laws are an important supplement to the Commission's enforcement actions and that the Commission has long supported both judicial and legislative steps to ensure that persons injured by violations of the securities laws will have meaningful civil remedies available to them. However, the overlap between private remedies under RICO and private remedies under the securities laws permits plaintiffs to bypass the carefully crafted provisions of the securities laws and, in some cases, to recover damages specifically prohibited under the securities laws.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

OFFER OF SETTLEMENT ACCEPTED FROM MARK L. STAHL

In public proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Mark L. Stahl submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted.

Stahl consented to an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions, which finds that he engaged in activities while he was associated with Shearson Lehman Brothers, Inc., a registered representative, which led to his conviction for violations of the wire fraud statute, 18 USC §1343 [U.S. v. Mark L. Stahl, 87-CR-549, SDNY, June 18, 1987].

The Order bars Stahl from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-27027)

OFFER OF SETTLEMENT ACCEPTED FROM OUTWATER & WELLS, INC.

> In public proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Outwater & Wells, Inc., a registered broker-dealer in Livingston, New Jersey, submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted.

> Outwater, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Final Order), which finds that from January-October 1987 and from May-October 1987, respectively, Outwater wilfully violated Sections 7(c) and 15(c) of the Exchange Act and Rule 15c3-3(m), and Regulation T of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System.

> The Final Order censures Outwater and orders that it be prohibited from clearing proprietary and customer securities transactions for 90 days. If Outwater resumes clearing activities after the 90-day period expires, it is ordered to implement and comply with certain undertakings. (Rel. 34-27028)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST JOSEPH A. BELMONTE, JR.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and Investment Company Act of 1940 against Joseph Anthony Belmonte, Jr. of Coconut Creek, Florida. Belmonte was previously registered as an investment adviser and was formerly associated with a registered broker-dealer.

The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that from about September 1983 until July 1988, Belmonte (1) sold approximately \$8 million of unregistered securities; (2) made misrepresentations and omissions of material facts to prospective investors and prospective clients; (3) failed to make and keep true, accurate, and current various required books and records; and (4) operated three unregistered investment companies, an unregistered broker-dealer and as an unregistered investment adviser. It also alleges that Belmonte thereby violated the antifraud and registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, Exchange Act, and Advisers Act, the recordkeeping provisions of the Advisers Act, and the registration provisions of the Investment Company Act. It further alleges that Belmonte was permanently enjoined on July 26, 1988 from violating the above provisions of the securities laws. (Rel. 34-27029)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTION AND RECEIVERSHIP ORDER ENTERED AGAINST ALPHA TRUST, OTHERS

> The Los Angeles Regional Office filed a Complaint on July 11 in federal court seeking injunctions against further registration and fraud violations by Alpha Trust, Robert J. Corsaut, and Omega Management Network, Inc. Defendants allegedly raised at least \$1.4 million by offering notes issued by Alpha Trust which supposedly generated 12% "interest" through conservative investment strategies. Alpha Trust was also supposedly structured as a trust with various charitable beneficiaries. According to the Complaint, the risks and uses of offering proceeds were not disclosed; no charitable trust beneficiaries were appointed; there was no substantive disclosure of the issuer's financial condition or the arrangements for compensating the promoters; and there was no disclosure of a cease and desist order against Corsaut, the revocation of Corsaut's Michigan insurance license, or Corsaut's criminal conviction for bank fraud. Following the defendants' consent, on July 12, the Court signed an Order permanently enjoining them from registration and fraud violations and appointing Edward S. Gelfand, a Los Angeles attorney, as temporary receiver. (SEC v. Alpha Trust, et al., Civil Action No. 89-4131 RSWL GHKx, CDCA). (LR-12163)

COMPLAINT NAMES ASK CORPORATION AND BRIAN D. PARDO

The Commission filed a Complaint on July 19 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against ASK Corporation and its chairman and chief executive officer, Brian D. Pardo. The Complaint alleges that defendants violated the antifraud and reporting provisions of the securities laws and that Pardo made false statements to ASK's auditors.

The Commission alleges that defendants materially overstated ASK's revenues and profits for the first three quarters in each of its 1983 and 1984 fiscal years, and the first two quarters in fiscal 1985 and that in connection therewith, defendants, in filings with the Commission, new releases, and letters to shareholders, made material misrepresentations. (SEC v. ASK Corporation and Brian P. Pardo, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 89-2038, JHP). (LR-12169; AAER-236)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BAILARD, BIEHL & KAISER INTERNATIONAL FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Bailard, Biehl & Kaiser International Fund, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 18(d), 18(f), 22(c), and 22(d) and Rule 22c-1 in connection with (1) the sale of Applicant's shares beyond the amount authorized by its Certificate of Incorporation, (2) the subsequent rescission offer to holders of such shares, and (3) the issuance of duly unathorized shares to replace the overissued shares. (Rel. IC-17071 - July 18)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MAINE YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Maine Yankee Atmoic Power Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to enter into and borrow under a revolving credit agreement with a syndicate of commercial banks up to \$50 million through August 31, 1992. In addition, Maine Yankee has been authorized to enter into and borrow under a Eurodollar Revolving Credit Agreement with a syndicate of international banks up to \$20 million through August 31, 1992. (Rel. 35-24925 - July 18)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: <u>The National Association</u> of <u>Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-89-24) to amend the definition of "direct participation programs" in Part II, Section 2(d)(ii) of Schedule C to its By-Laws to exclude certain freely tradeable partnership securities. (Rel. 34-27036); and <u>The Chicago Board</u> <u>Options Exchange</u> (SR-CBOE-89-13) to clarify the intent of the position limit rule. (Rel. 34-27037)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 17.
