COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSED RULE 12d1-1

The Comission is proposing for public comment Rule 12d1-1 under the Investment Company Act of 1940. Proposed Rule 12d1-1 would provide an exemption from the limitations imposed by Section 12(d)(1)(A) of that Act for acquisitions of securities of foreign banks and foreign insurance companies by registered investment companies.

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF FLORIDA PENNY STOCK TASK FORCE

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announce the first anniversary of the Florida Penny Stock Task Force. On July 11, the Miami Branch Office held its fifth quarterly meeting of the Task Force in Miami.

The Task Force is comprised of representatives from the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. Districts No. 7 (Atlanta, Georgia) and No. 3 (Denver, Colorado), the Anti-Fraud Section of the NASD (Washington, DC), Florida Division of Securities, Georgia Secretary of State's Office, Federal Bureau of Investigation, United States Attorney's Office, Internal Revenue Service-Criminal Intelligence Division, and the Commission's Miami Branch, Atlanta Regional, Chicago Regional, and New York Regional Offices, and the Divisions of Enforcement and Market Regulation.

The purpose of the meeting was to report on the first year's activities of the Task Force, to consider new methods of continuing public education about penny stock fraud, to discuss criminal law enforcement activities, regulatory activities, examinations and enforcement activities, penny stock trends in the southeastern United States, and methods of developing new tactics and strategies for regulating, investigating, and prosecuting penny stock broker-dealers.

[The Miami Branch Office acknowledges the substantial participation in the Florida Penny Stock Task Force by Mr. Bennett Whipple, Vice President and District Director of NASD District No. 7, and Mr. Don B. Saxon, Director of the Florida Division of Securities.]

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

MICHAEL HELVEY ENJOINED AND ASSETS FROZEN

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on July 19 U.S. District Court Judge John W. Potter, Northern District of Ohio, entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Michael J. Helvey, an investment adviser and registered representative, freezing Helvey's assets, ordering ancillary equitable relief, and enjoining him from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and the reporting, books and records, and other provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940.

The July 19 Complaint alleged that since at least June 1987, Helvey misappropriated approximately \$122,000 from clients by means of a scheme which involved the redemption of client securities by means of forged client redemption requests and appropriation of the proceeds for his own use. He also directly misappropriated \$60,000 from another client by depositing in his own account funds the client had given him for investment purposes. (SEC v. Michael J. Helvey, Civil Action No. 3:89CV7416, USDC NDOH). (LR-12177)

ROBERT RIDENOUR ENJOINED IN INTERPOSITIONING SCHEME

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on July 12 Judge Donald E. O'Brien entered Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Order and Judgment against Robert L. Ridenour, permanently enjoining him from further violations of the antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws. The Order and Judgment, entered after a trial on the merits, require Ridenour to disgorge \$470,287.23, plus interest, from April 25, 1985, the date the Commission began its action. The disgorgement figure represents the profits which accrued to Ridenour in an interpositioning scheme involving over 129 individual transactions which took place from November 1979 through January 1984.

Ridenour was employed as a registered representative for Dean Witter Reynolds, Inc. in its Des Moines, Iowa, office at the time of his violative conduct. Ridenour established secret accounts away from Dean Witter which he interposed between his clients' securities transactions and the true market for those transactions. Ridenour's customers were primarily small Iowa banks which did not have access to the sophisticated bond market pricing information available to Ridenour by virtue of his position as a Dean Witter institutional bond salesman. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HOME LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 21 to request a hearing on an application by Home Life Insurance Company, Home Life Separate Account V, W.S. Griffith & Co., Inc., and Wood Logan Associates, for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(C)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account. (Rel. IC-17080 - July 25)

DREYFUS LIFE AND ANNUITY INDEX FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by Dreyfus Life and Annuity Index Fund, Inc. and certain life insurance companies and variable life insurance separate accounts investing therein (collectively, Applicants) for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) to permit mixed and shared funding. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved the following proposed rule changes filed by The Philadelphia Stock Exchange: (SR-Phlx-89-33) relating to the responsibility of specialists and registered options traders to make ten-up markets. (Rel. 34-27051); and (SR-Phlx-89-18) authorizing foreign currency options participants to be elected to serve as members of its Board of Governors. (Rel. 34-27054)

TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on a pilot basis until December 30, 1989, a proposed rule change filed by the Depository Trust Company. The proposal (SR-DTC-89-1) concerns DTC's plans to eliminate most Certificate-on-Demand urgent withdrawals of corporate issues settling in next-day funds that are not full Fast Automated Securities Transfer issues and replace this service with a new rush transfer service for those issues. The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-89-12) to make certain technical changes to its rules. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 24. (Rel. 34-27053)
