COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC ANNOUNCES EIGHTH ANNUAL GOVERNMENT-BUSINESS FORUM ON SMALL BUSINESS CAPITAL FORMATION

The Commission announced that it will be holding the Eighth Annual Government-Business Forum on Small Business Capital Formation on Thursday, September 21 and Friday, September 22, 1989. The Forum is to be held at the Westin Hotel in Washington, DC.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SETTLED AGAINST BOGEY ENTERPRISES, INC. AND RICHARD A. BENNETT, JR.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Bogey Enterprises, Inc., a registered investment adviser, and its president and owner, Richard A. Bennett, Jr. Simultaneously, they submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted. The Order, to which Bogey and Bennett consented without admitting or denying the findings contained therein, imposes censures against them.

The Commission fuond that Bogey violated Sections 203, 204, 205, and 206 of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and rules thereunder, and that Bennett aided and abetted Bogey's violations. Specifically, Bogey failed to: have an independent public accountant audit its balance sheets; maintain books and records; furnish its

clients with a written disclosure statement; maintain brochure records; provide in its investment advisory contracts a provision that such contracts could not be assigned without the clients consent; maintain client funds; and have client funds in its custody verified by annual examination by an independent public accountant. (Rel. IA-1180)

WALTZER AND ASSOCIATES AND LEWIS N. WALTZER SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Waltzer and Associates (Associates), a registered investment adviser, and its general partner, Lewis N. Waltzer, based upon violations of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. The Commission alleged that Waltzer violated the advertising rules by claiming in published advertisements that his advisory clients earned an average of 22% on his recommendations, when the average was not based upon the investment performance of Waltzer's clients, but on the average performance of mutual funds recommended by him. The Commission also alleged that Waltzer aided and abetted various books and records violations committed by Associates.

Simultaneously, the Commission accepted settlement offers in which respondents, without admitting or denying the alleged violations, consented to a Commission order censuring Associates and suspending Waltzer from associating with any investment adviser, investment company, broker, dealer, or municipal securities dealer for 30 days. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAING ORDERED ISSUED AGAINST JURY MATT HANSEN, OTHERS

The New York Regional Office announced that on August 3 U.S. District Court Judge Richard Owen, Southern District of New York, issued a Temporary Restraining Order and Temporary Asset Freeze against Jury Matt Hansen, Fergus M. Sloan, Jr., Fermat Associates, and Graycliff International, S.A., doing business as 76 other entities, from further violations of the antifraud and credit extension provisions of the securities laws.

The Complaint charged that defendants opened 250 accounts at over 100 broker-dealers using 76 fictitious entity names and purchased securities without sufficient money to pay for said purchases. Instead, defendants used the proceeds from the same day sale of said securities to pay for their purchase. It also alleged that defendants ordered the purchase of securities with the intention of paying for said securities only if their market value did not decline precipitously. In connection with the above-described conduct, defendants designated Toronto Dominion Bank as their delivery versus payment/receipt versus payment agent. It further alleged that Toronto Dominion violated the credit extension provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Jury Matt Hansen, et al., USDC SDNY, 89 Civ. 5242, RO). (LR-12193)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST RICHARD SCHREIBER

The Commission filed a Complaint on August 3 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas seeking to enjoin Richard Schreiber, former labor lawyer with Burlington Northern Railroad (BNR), from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Complaint further seeks disgorgement of Schreiber's unlawful profits of \$23,889.48 and imposition of a civil penalty in the amount of \$23,889.48 under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984 (ITSA). Schreiber, without admitting or denying the Complaint's allegations, consented to a Final Judgment and agreed to pay the disgorgement and ITSA penalty.

The Complaint alleges that on or about March 24, 1988, Schreiber first learned material nonpublic information concerning an impending corporate restructuring by Burlington Northern, Inc. (BNI), BNR's former parent company. It also alleges that Schreiber was informed of the restructuring so that he could advise BNR concerning labor litigation strategies. It further alleges that, while in possession of this information, Schreiber purchased common stock and options for common stock of BNI which he sold at a profit following BNI's June 2, 1988 announcement of the restructuring. (SEC v. Richard Schreiber, Civil Action No. CA-4-89-549-K, NDTX, August 3, 1989). (LR-12194)

SELECT*PROTECTOR VARIABLE ACCOUNT; NEW ENGLAND VARIABLE ANNUITY FUND II

Orders have been issued declaring that Select*Protector Variable Account and New England Variable Annuity Fund II have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-17093; IC-17095 - August 2)

THE MITSUBISHI BANK, LIMITED

An order has been issued exempting The Mitsubishi Bank, Limited, a Japanese commercial bank, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance and sale of its equity securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-17094 - August 2)
